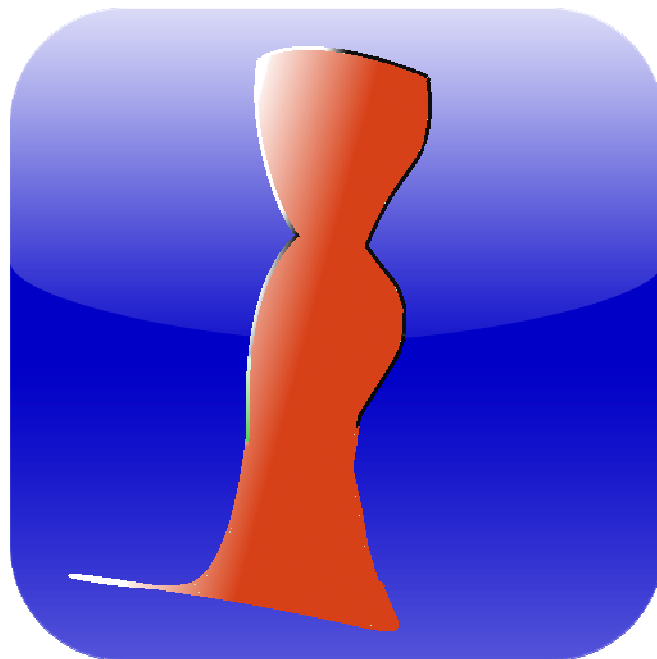


iDresser User Guide



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Overview

How often have you been flicking through your wardrobe looking for something to wear, or spreading item across you bedroom just before your are due to get ready for a special occasion, or you cannot remember the combination that caused a smash at your last office part.

The above dilemmas are a thing of past with iDresser. iDresser is an iPhone/Pod utility application that will take the guess work out of picking the right clothes for the right occasion. No more spreading the content of your dresser across the room in search of the ideal combinations. No more wondering if the item in the shop matches your wardrobe. Pack your suitcase in record time from the iDresser suitcase before your next trip. If in doubt contact one of the worlds leading image consultants for advice.

With iDresser you can:

- Capture you wardrobe to your phone.
- Browse your wardrobe from the comfort of your iPhone.
- Mix and match items to form outfits.
- Keep track of when your last wore an item.
- Select items for your next trip and add to your suitcase.
- Mix and match items while shopping with your wardrobe.
- Share your wardrobe via online Back up and restore facility
- Seek advice from one of worlds leading image consultants.

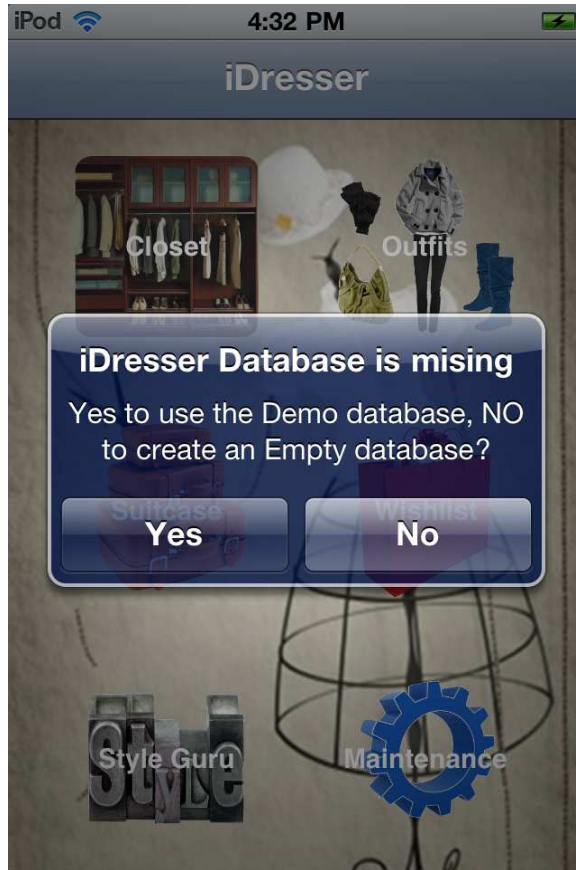
Quick Start

iDresser is installed from the iTunes Store.

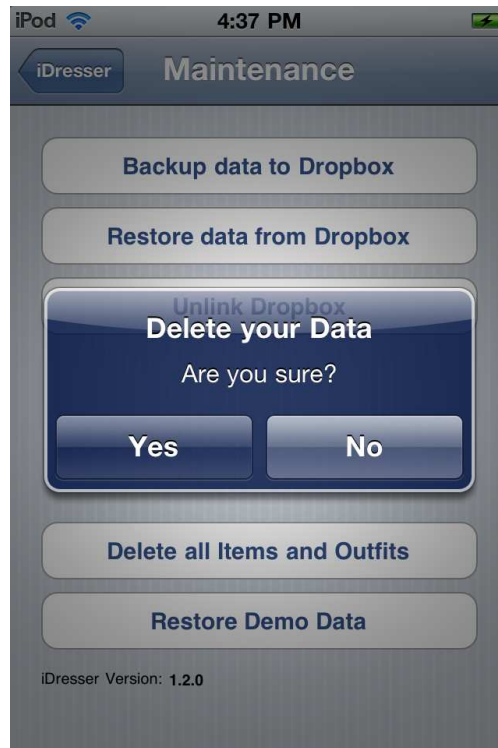


Once installed click on the iDresser icon

At start up for the first time you will see a prompt asking you to start up with an empty closet, or use the demonstration wardrobe to familiarise your self with iDresser before building your own wardrobe.



Once you are familiar with iDresser you simple empty the closet and start your own dresser.



Main Menu

On start up iDresser will open the closet doors and present a main menu



The main menu consists of the following options:

Closet	Used to browse, add or remove items from your closet
Outfits	Used to mix and match items from closet into outfits
Suitcase	Used to view items and outfits added to your suitcase
Whish list	Used to mix and match shopping items with items in your closet.
Style Guru	Provides access to one of the worlds leading style gurus.
House Keeping	Backup and restore your wardrobe online

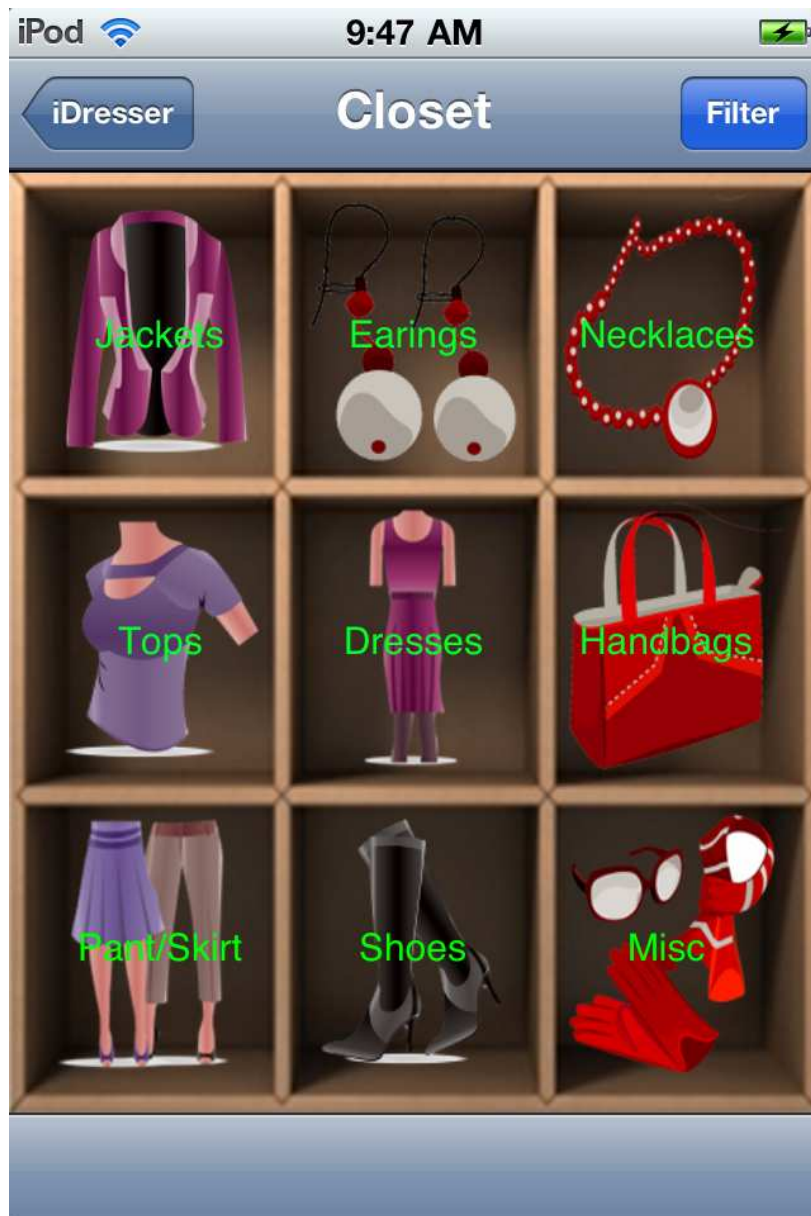
Simply touch the desired button to perform your desired task.



Closet

Touch the Closet menu button to browse add and remove items from your closet.

On entry closet display a dresser with nine compartments and a title bar containing left and right navigation buttons.



The closet consists of nine draws.

Jackets
Tops
Pant/Skirts

Earrings
Dresses
Shoes

Necklaces
Handbags
Miscellaneous

Touch a closet draw to browse, add or remove items from the draw.



An image of the item from the closet draw is displayed.
Drag the image left or right to browse through the draw items.

Use the toolbar at the bottom for the following:

Case

Touch case to add an item to your suitcase



If an item is in your suitcase, it will be indicated on the item image view.

If the item is already in your suitcase, touching case will remove the item from your suitcase



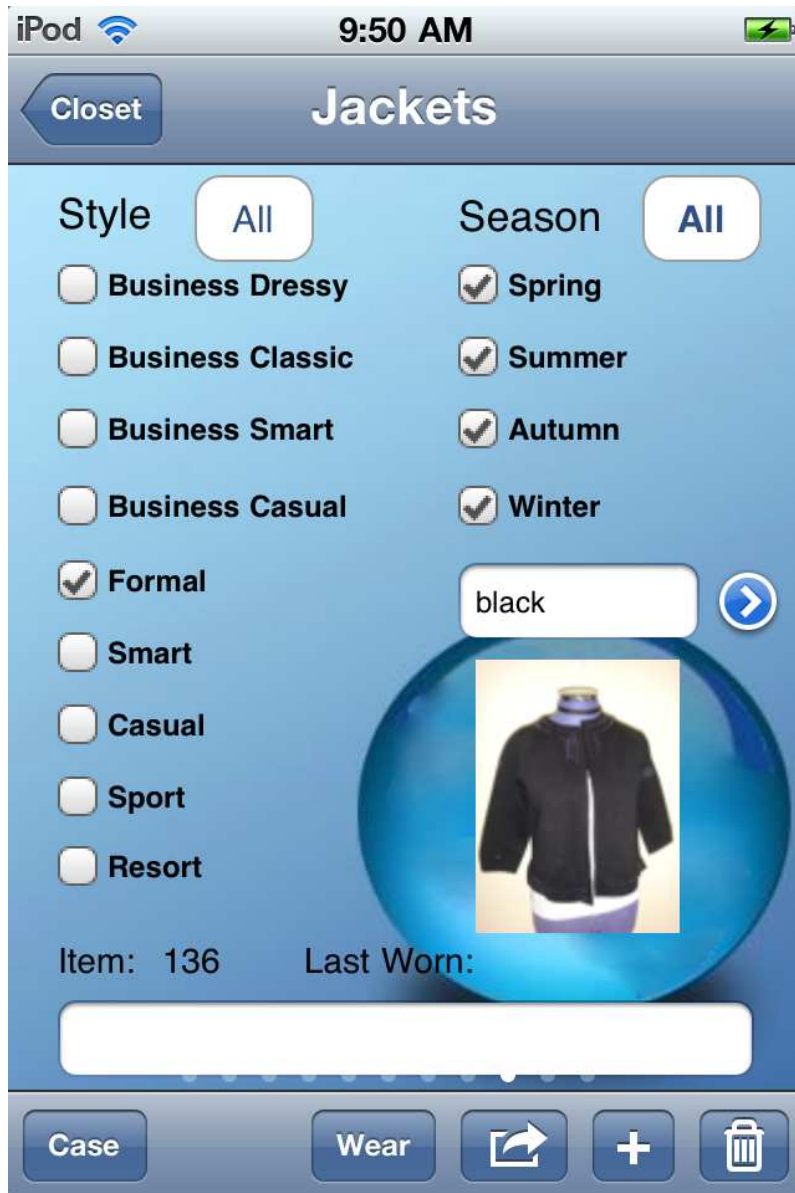
Wear

Touch the wear button and the last worn date and time is set to now.

Info




Touch the info button to see the information associated with the current item



The info view is used to indicate the Style, Season, Color, Last Worn date and a comment associated with item.
All information entered can be used as search criteria to filter [\(add link\)](#) selected subset of the closet.

Add



Touch  to add an item to the closet.

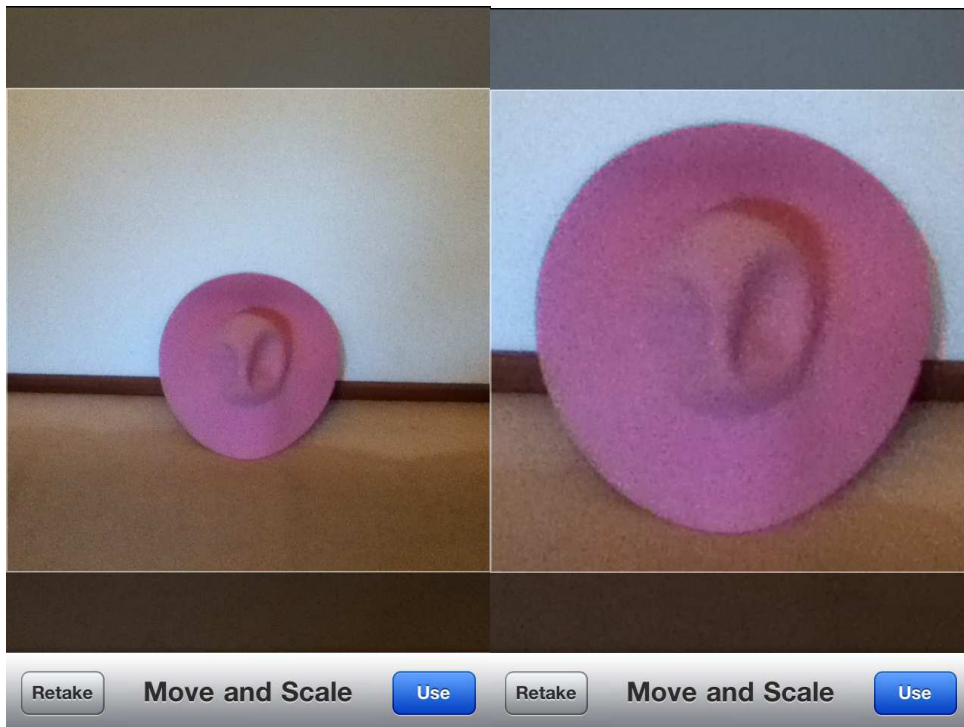
On selection the image capture view is display. You can take a new photo, choose an existing photo from your Photo library or cancel.



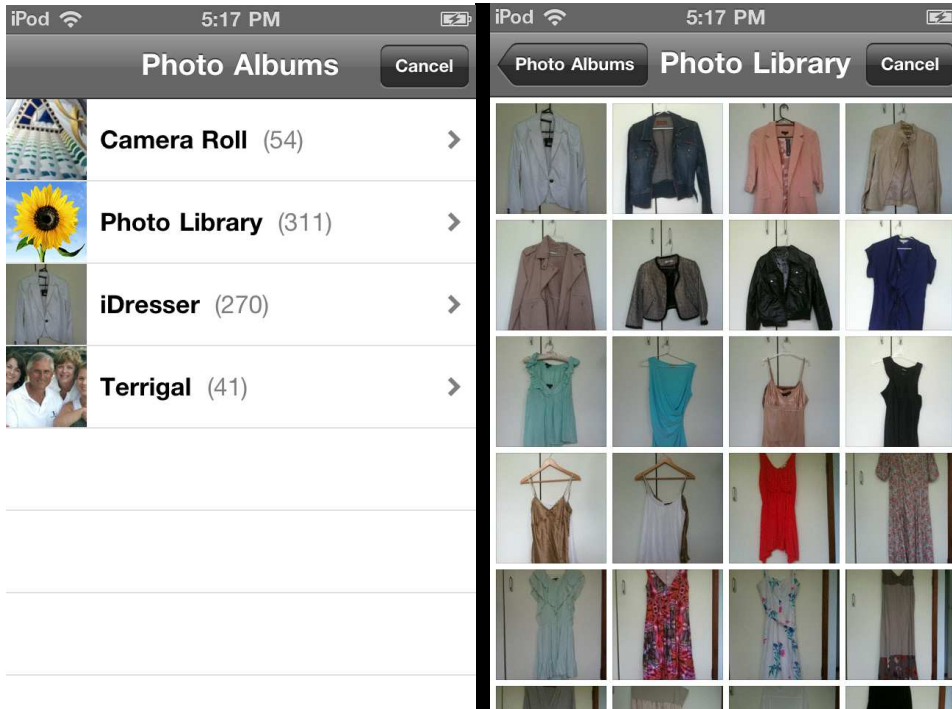
Touch "Take New Photo"



Once the picture is taken you can move and scale the image by pinching and dragging to achieve the optimum pan or zoom for saving in to the closet.



or touch “Choose an Existing Photo” to use photos already capture with you favourite Camera App.



Your photo library will be displayed.


Touch the desired image



Touch "Use" if you have taken the photo with iDresser or "Choose" if selected from your phot library.

The image will be displayed ready to be assigned a style and saved into the closet.



Touch the info button  you must select at least one style and an optional season, colour or comment and press the save button at the right of the display.




Touch Save to add the new item to the closet.



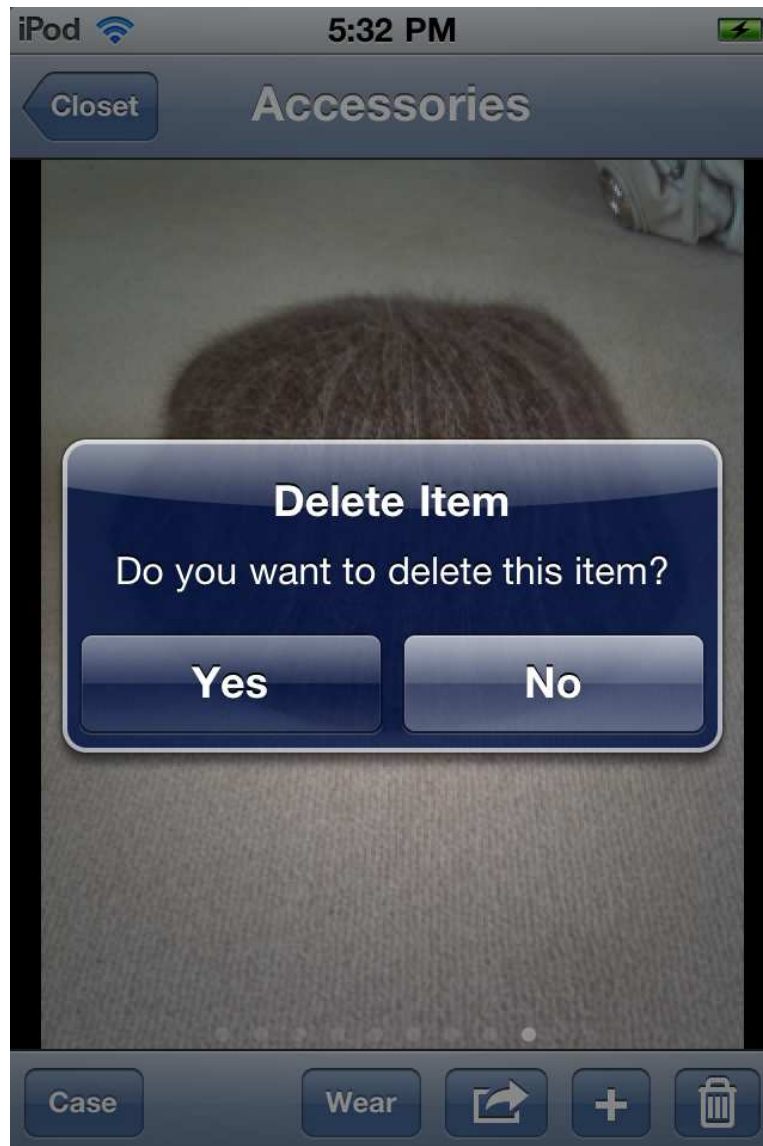
The new item will be appended to the end of the items in the current draw.

Delete



Touch  to delete the current displayed item.

A prompt will be displayed asking you to confirm you which to delete the item.

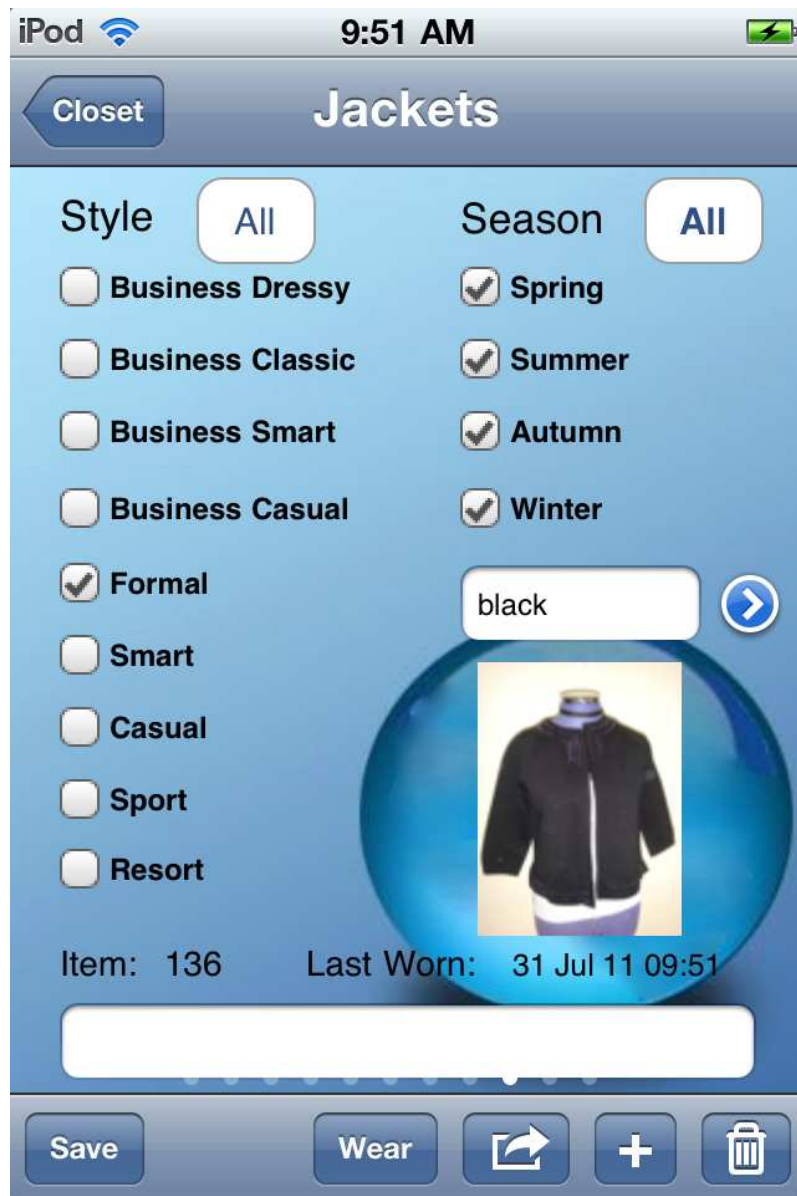


If yes is selected the item is deleted and the next item in the closet is displayed.
If no is selected the item is redisplay.

Closet Info View



When browsing the closet if you touch the info button the Closet Item Detail View is displayed.



When a change is made to an item, the Case button on the bottom left of the display changes to Save.

Once touched the changes are saved to the closet, the Save button changes back to the Case button.

If you return to the image view with out saving any changes that have been made, a prompt is displayed asking to confirm if you wish to Save the changes or not.

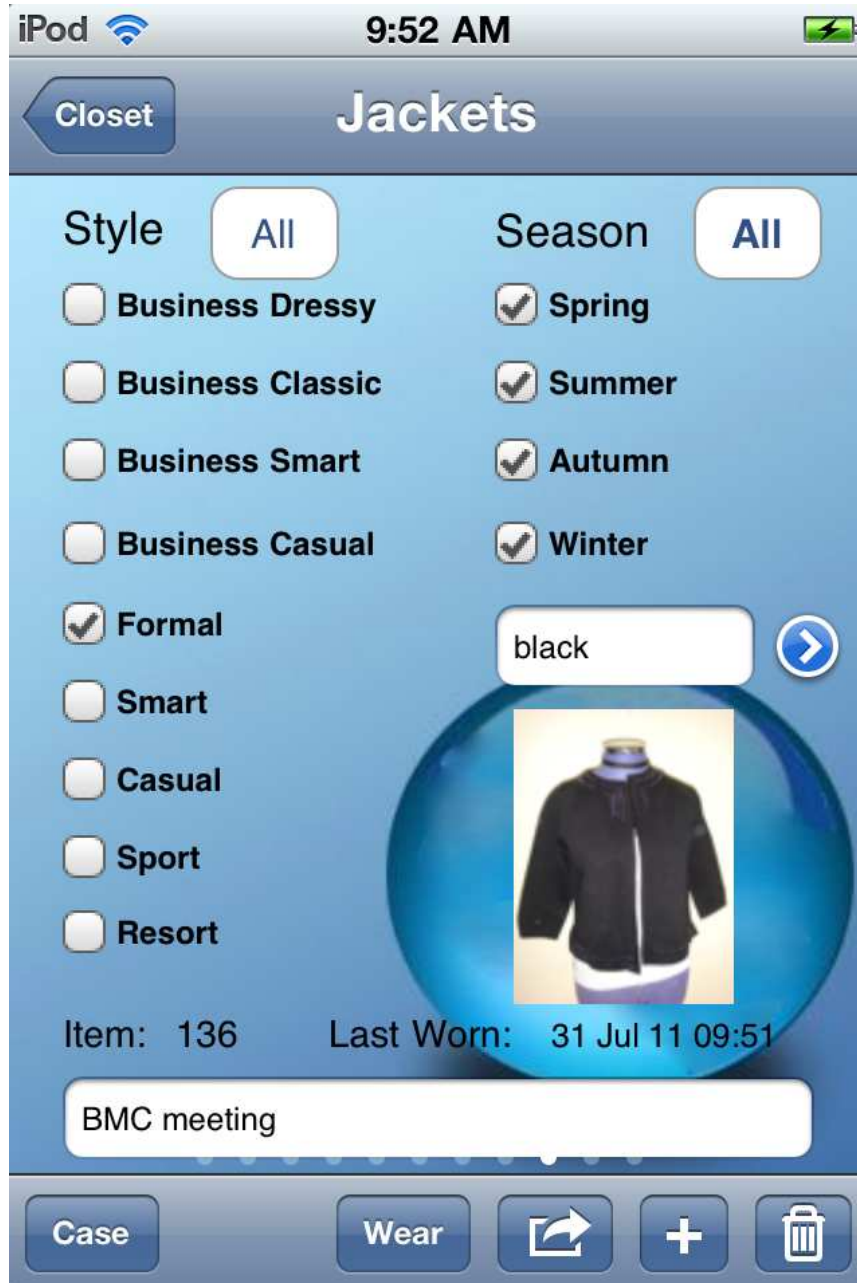


Style & Season

Touch a toggle button to select or unselect a Style or Season.

An item must be associated with at least one style to be saved to the closet.

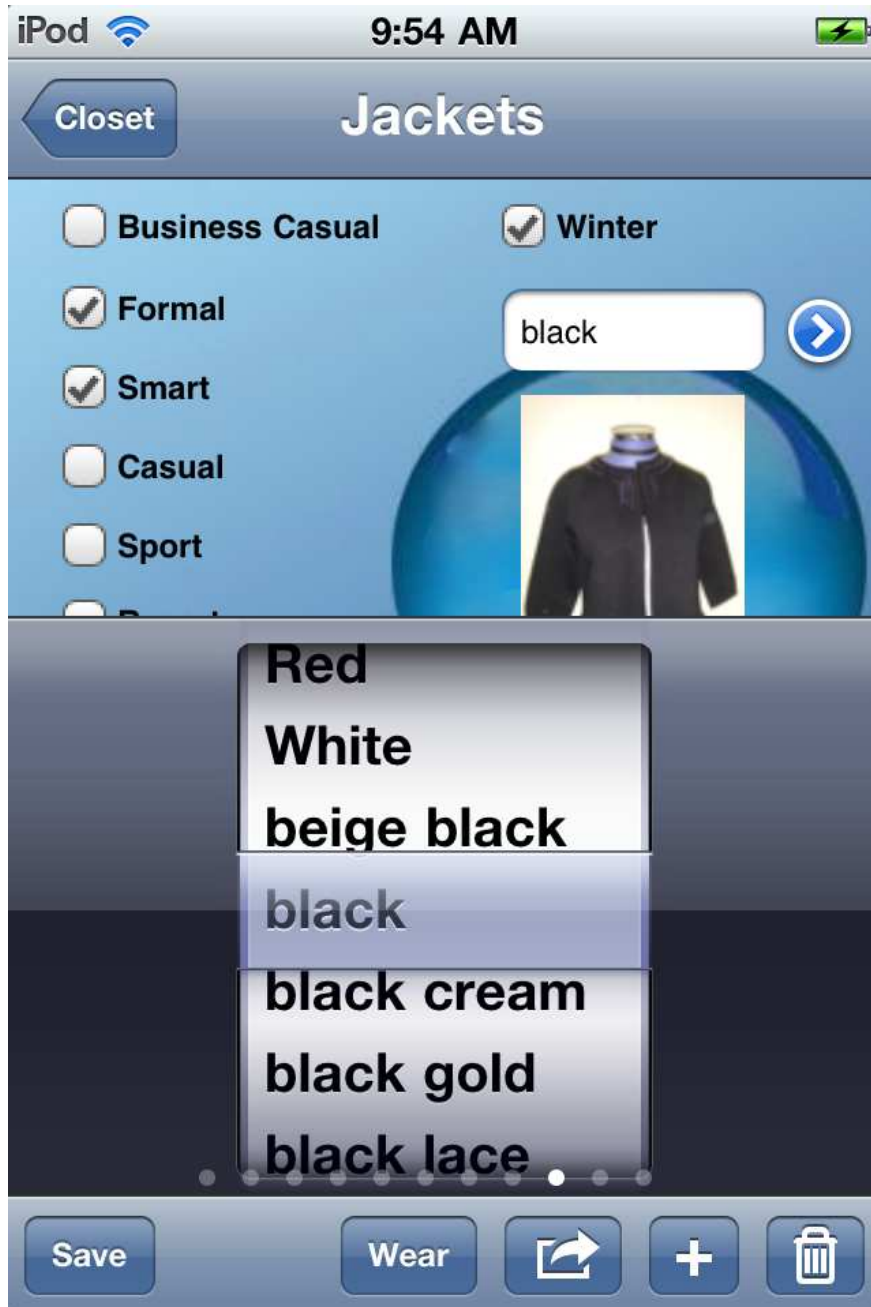
An item may be associated with one or more Styles.



All other items are optional.

Colour

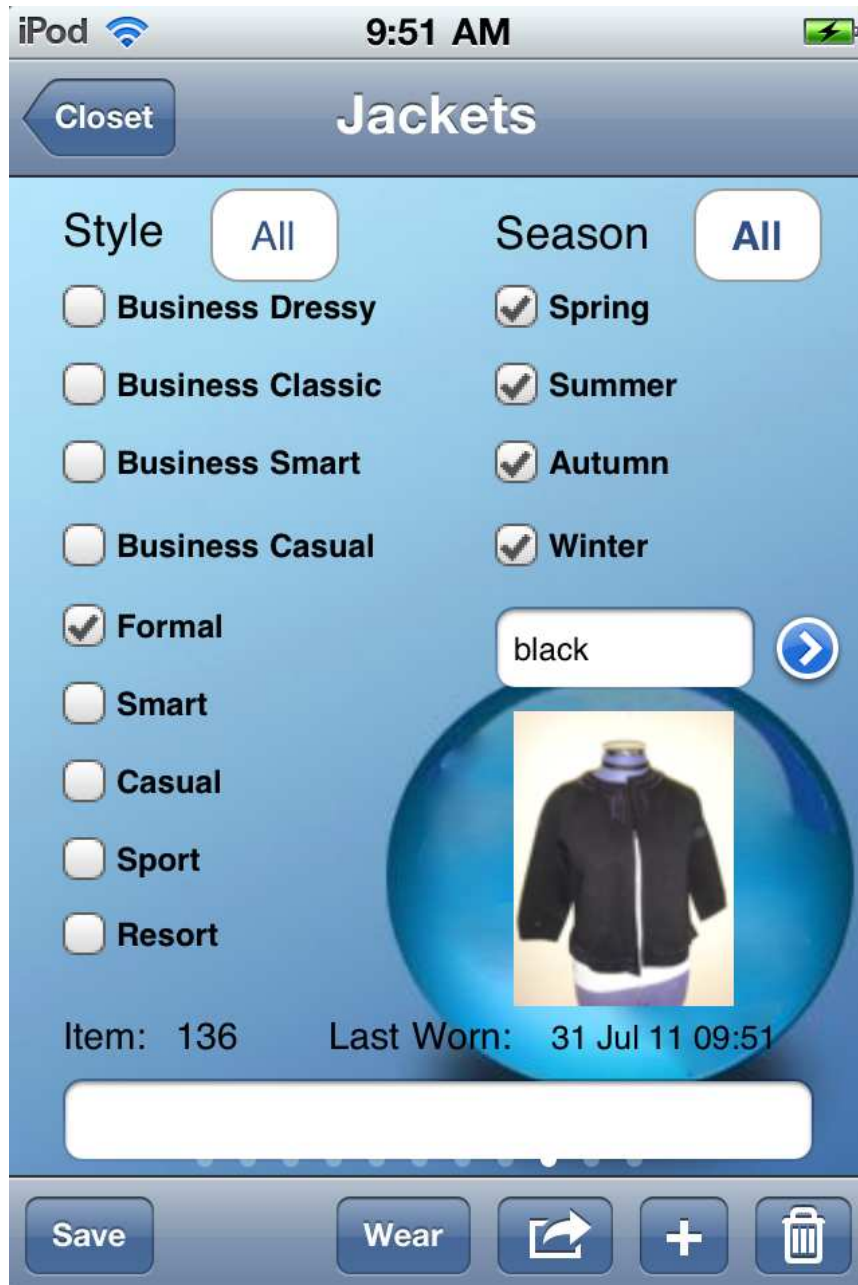
Colour can be entered by selecting the text box and typing in a new colour, or selecting an existing previously entered colour.



Each time a colour is entered that is not in the existing list, it is saved and will appear in the colour pick list in alphabetical order next time the colour pick list is displayed.

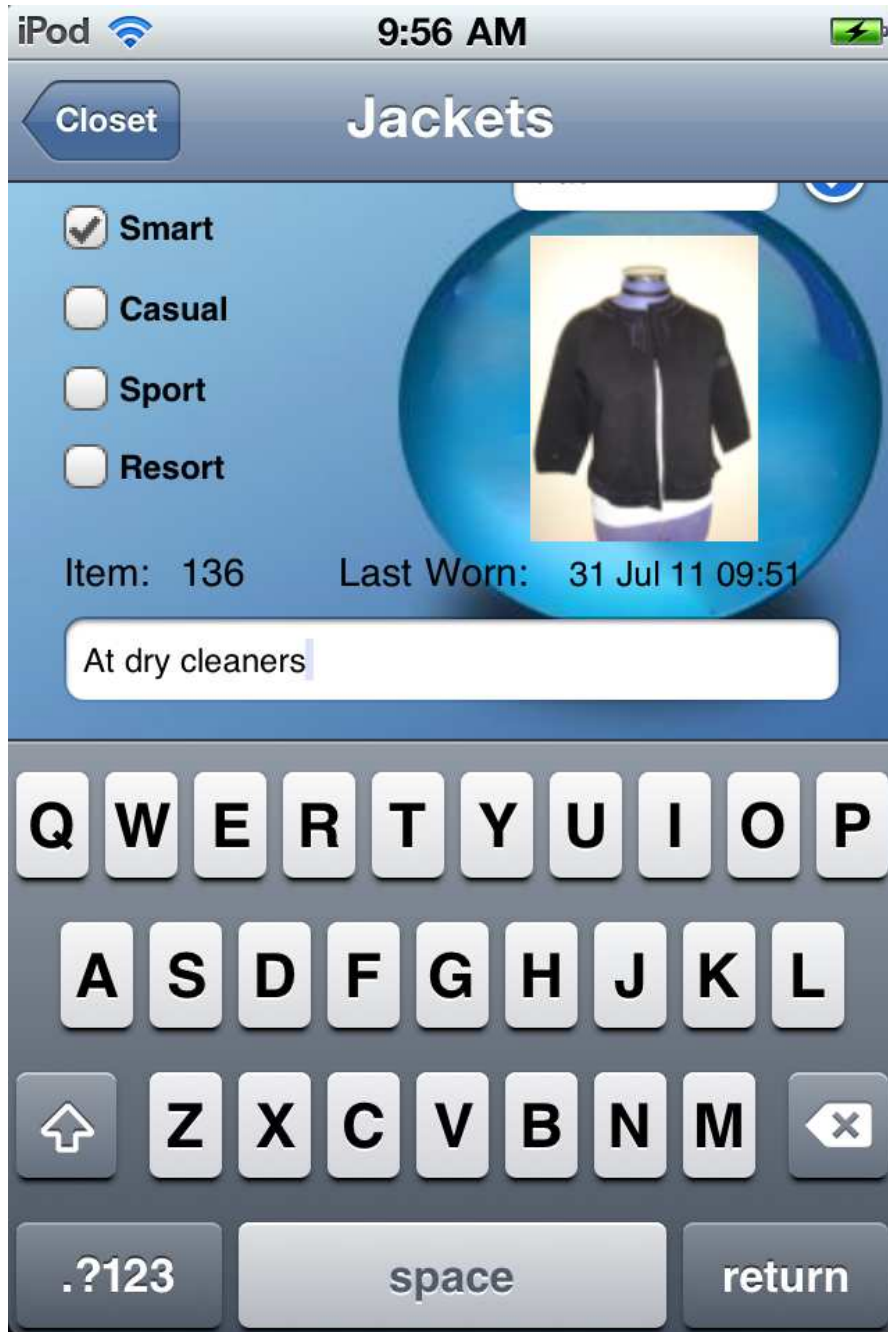
Last Worn

Touch the Wear button and the current date and time is displayed in the Last Worn text panel.



Comment

Touch comment to enter any think you want be associated with the current item. i.e. at the dry cleaners, Melbourne Cup



Return to the Closet

To leave the item draw and return to the closet touch the Closet button



at the top left of the Item Image view.



Return to main Menu

To leave the Closet and return to the Main Menu touch the iDresser button



at the top left of the Closet view.

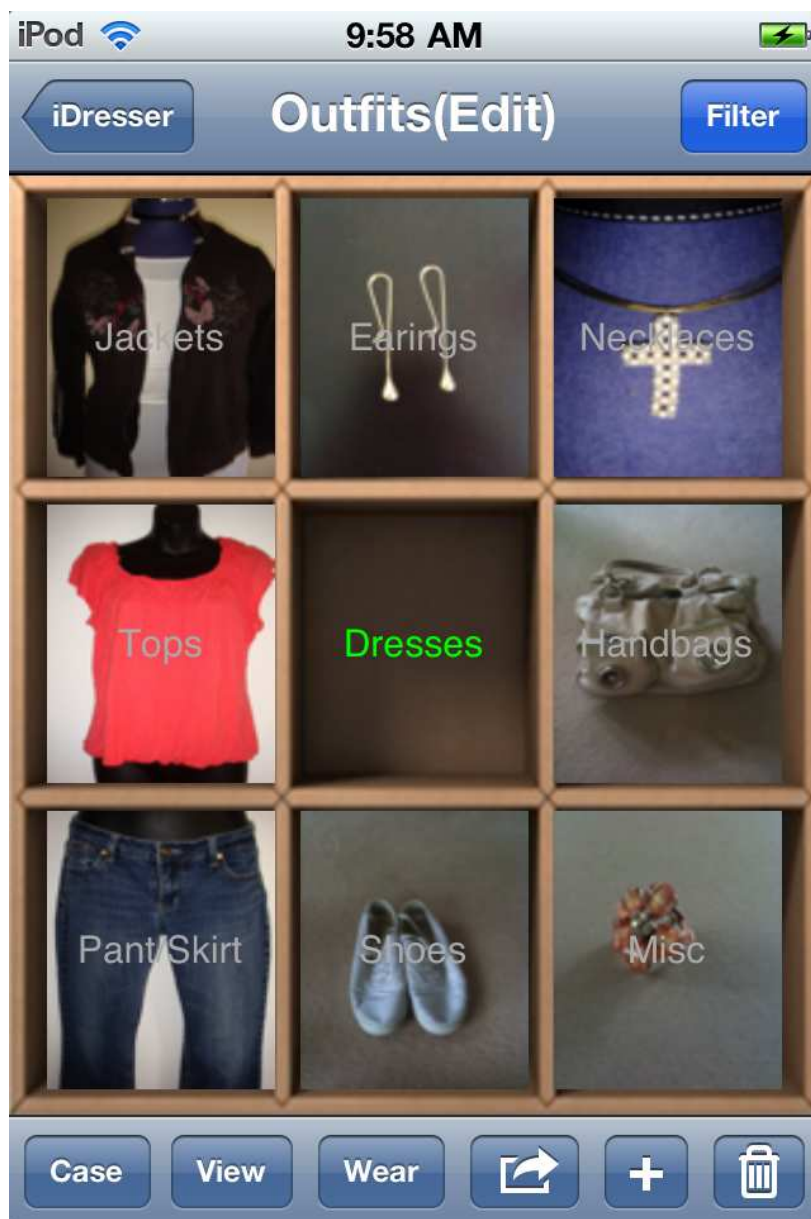




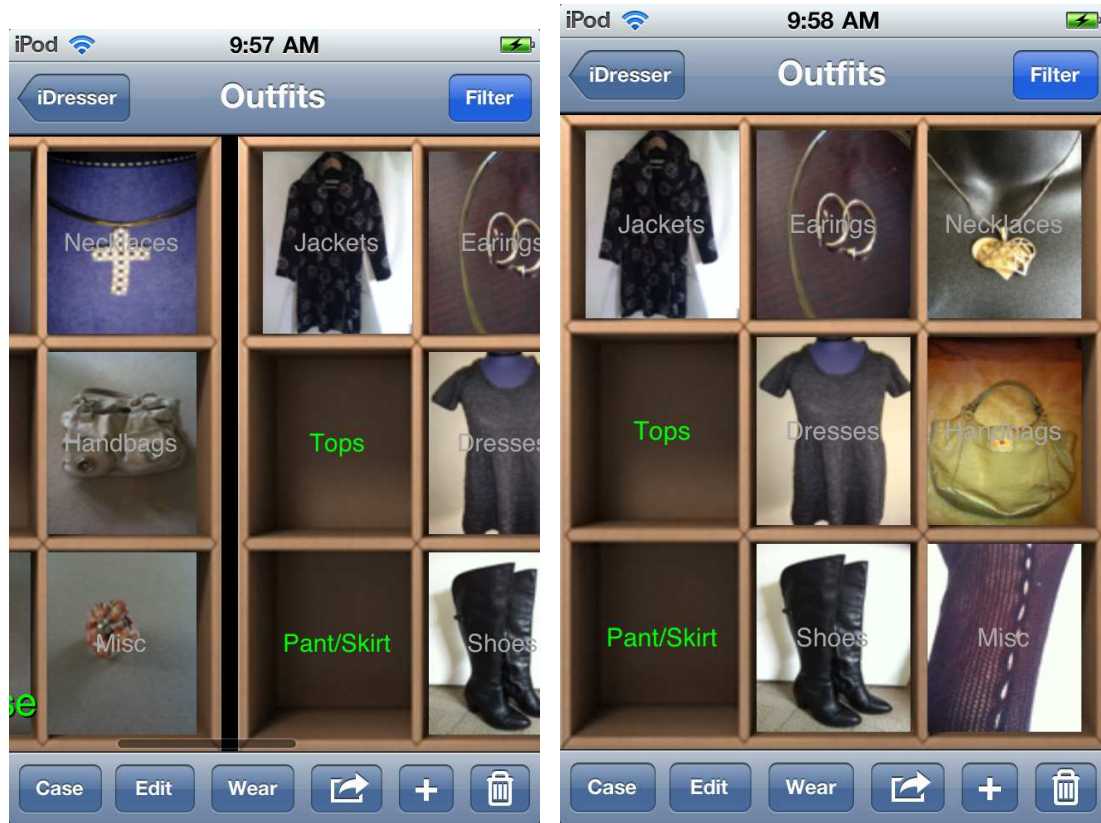
Outfit

On touching the Outfit menu button the Outfit browser displays the first Outfit. Some or all of the draws will display a thumbnail image of a closet item. These items when combined together form an outfit.

A title bar containing left and right navigation buttons similar to the Closet View is also displayed.



Drag your finger left or right to browse your outfits.

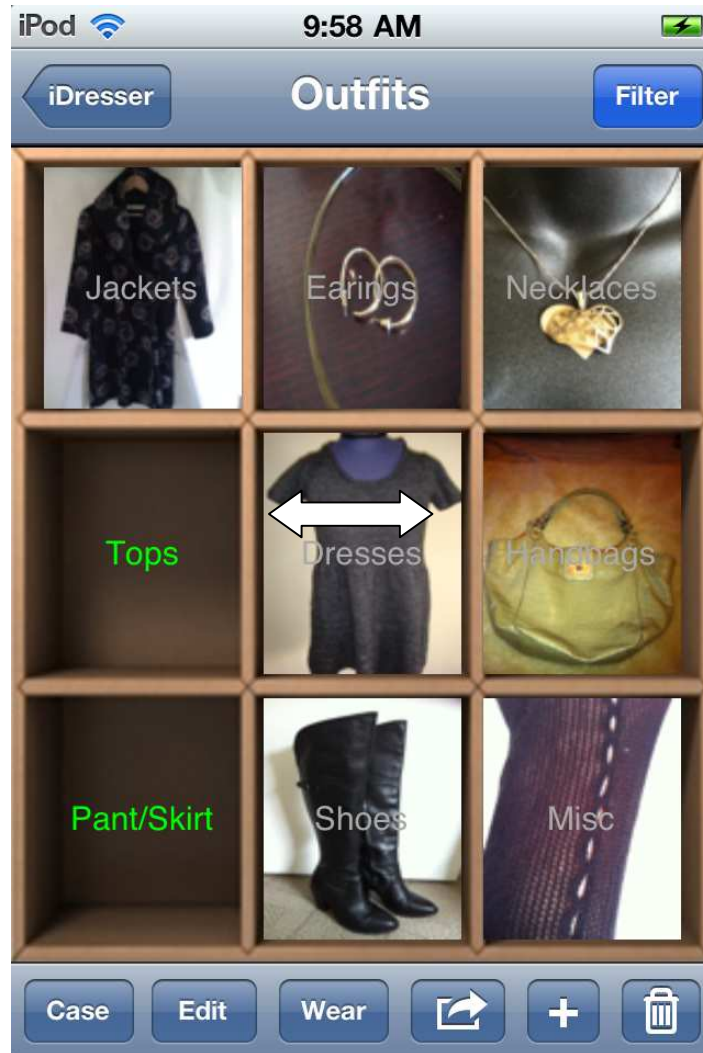


The iDresser navigation button at the top left will return you to iDresser Main Menu.

The toolbar at the bottom at the bottom is the same as for the closet view with one addition Edit button.

Edit

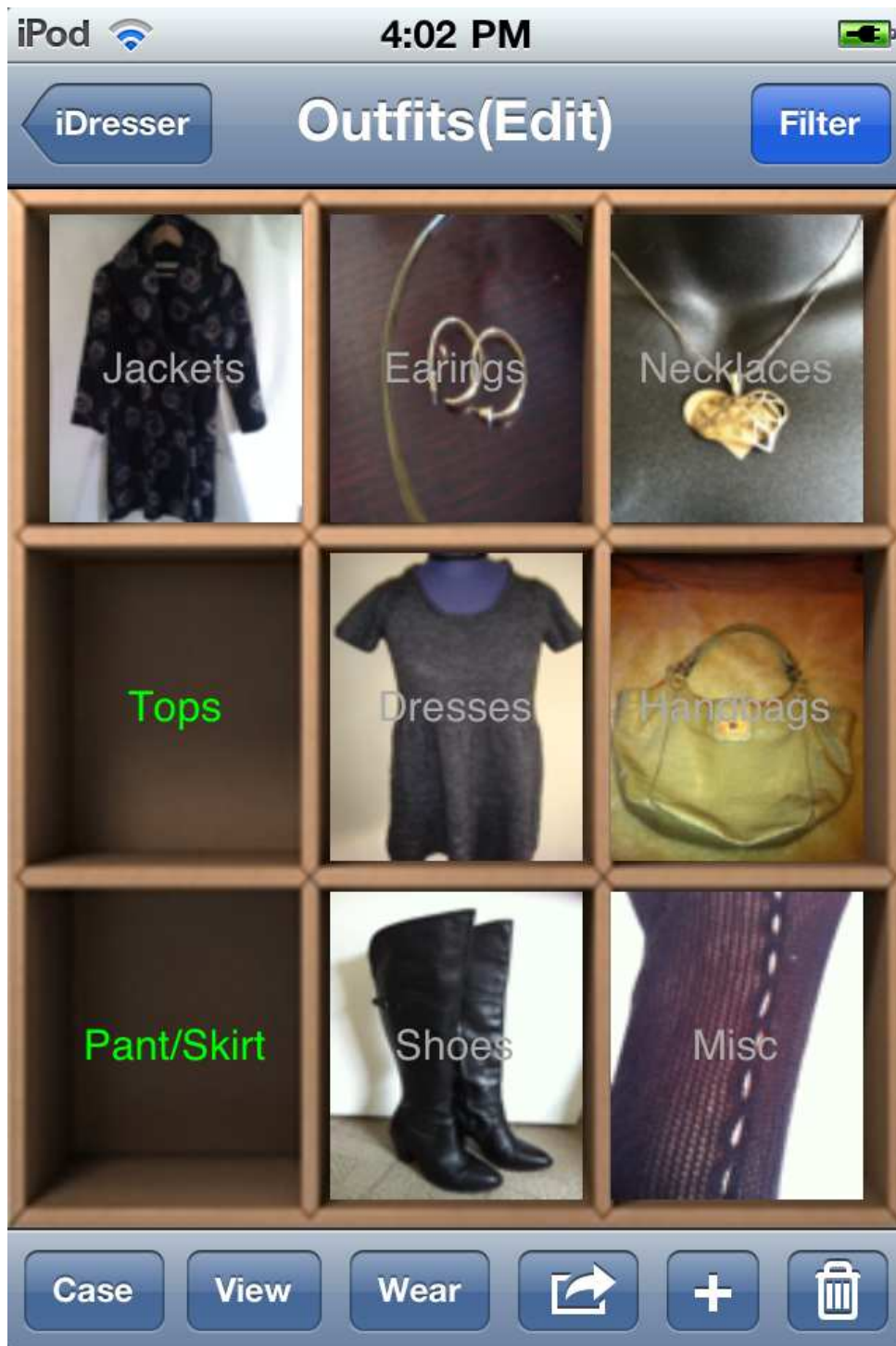
The Edit button exists to avoid accidental changes to your outfits while browsing. When the Edit button is displayed in the toolbar dragging your finger across the outfit will scroll to the backwards and forwards through your outfits.



When Edit is touched the button changes to the View Button and the title displays "Outfits(Edit)".

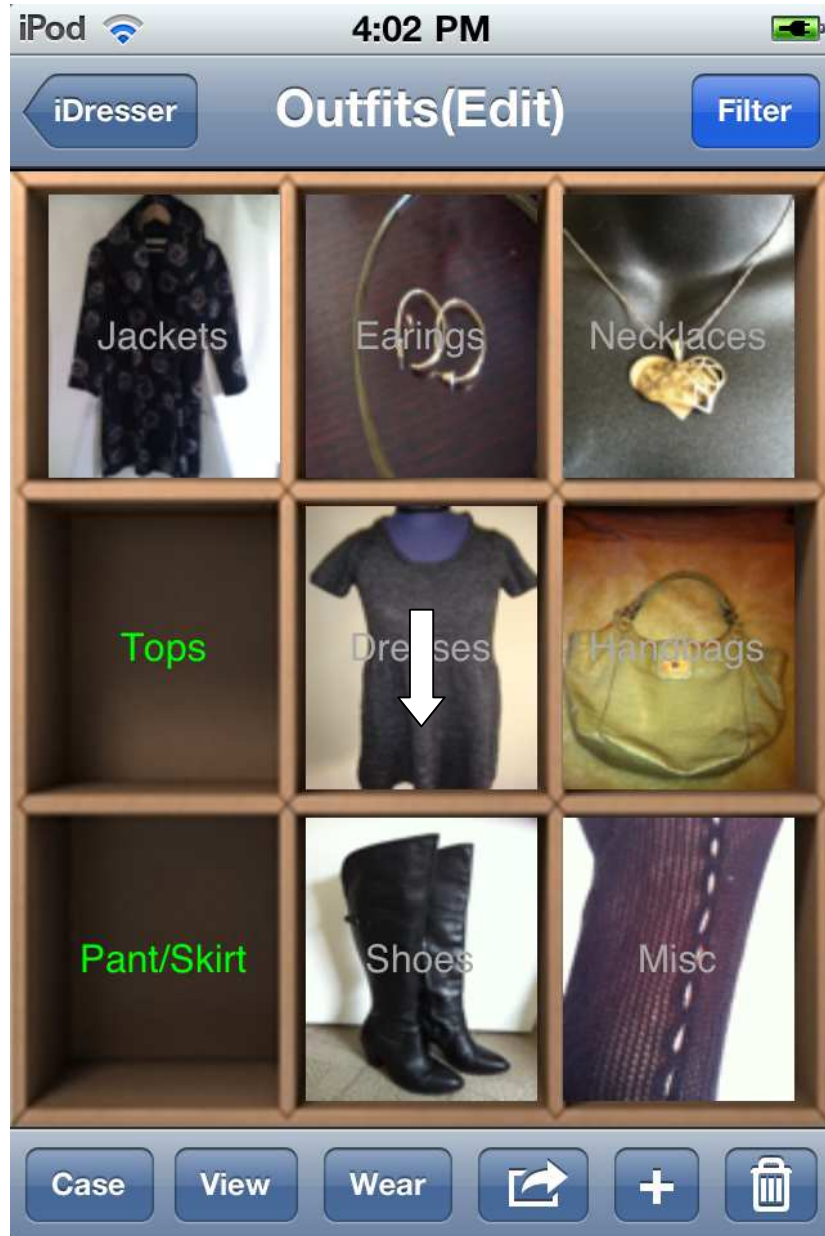
Summary of Outfit(Edit) Mode Gestures

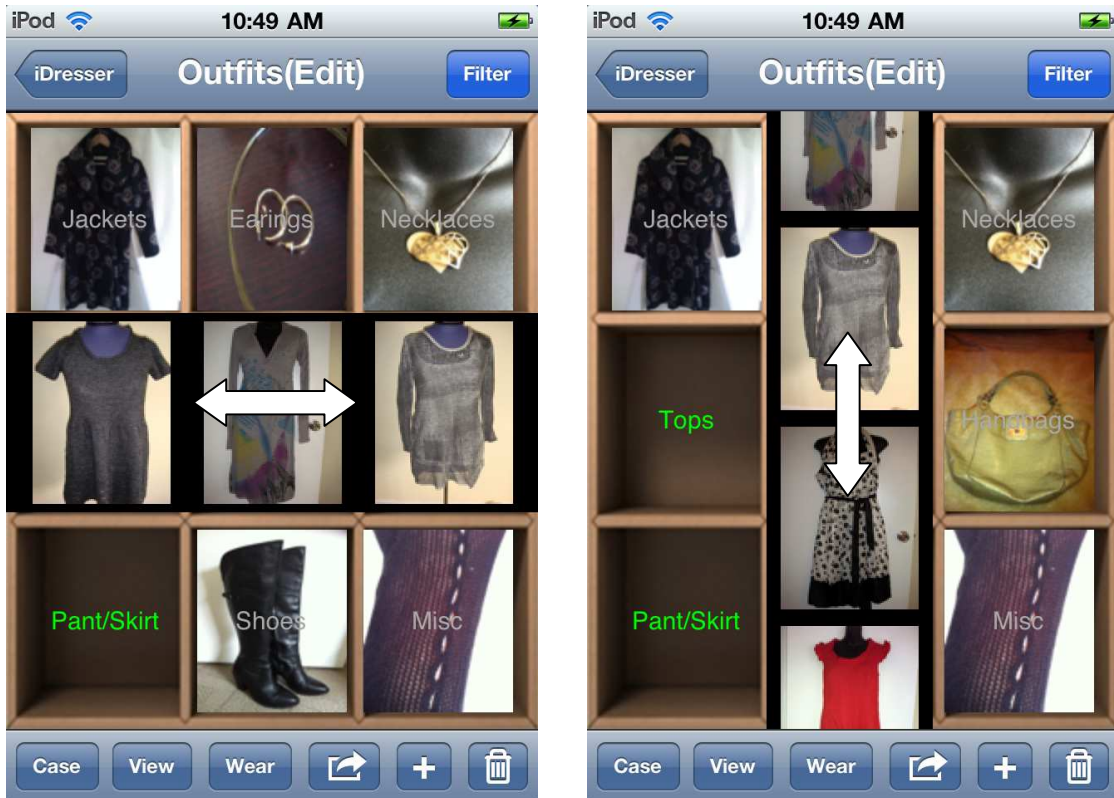
Drag Item horizontal	Pop up horizontal scrolling selection list of items
Drag item vertical	Pop up vertical scrolling selection list of items
Double tap outfit item	Delete item from the outfit
Touch scrolling thumbnail item	Select item to outfit
Drag scrolling thumbnail item at right angles to direction of scroll	Cancel the selection of an item and close the scrolling list of items. Does not change the original outfit item.



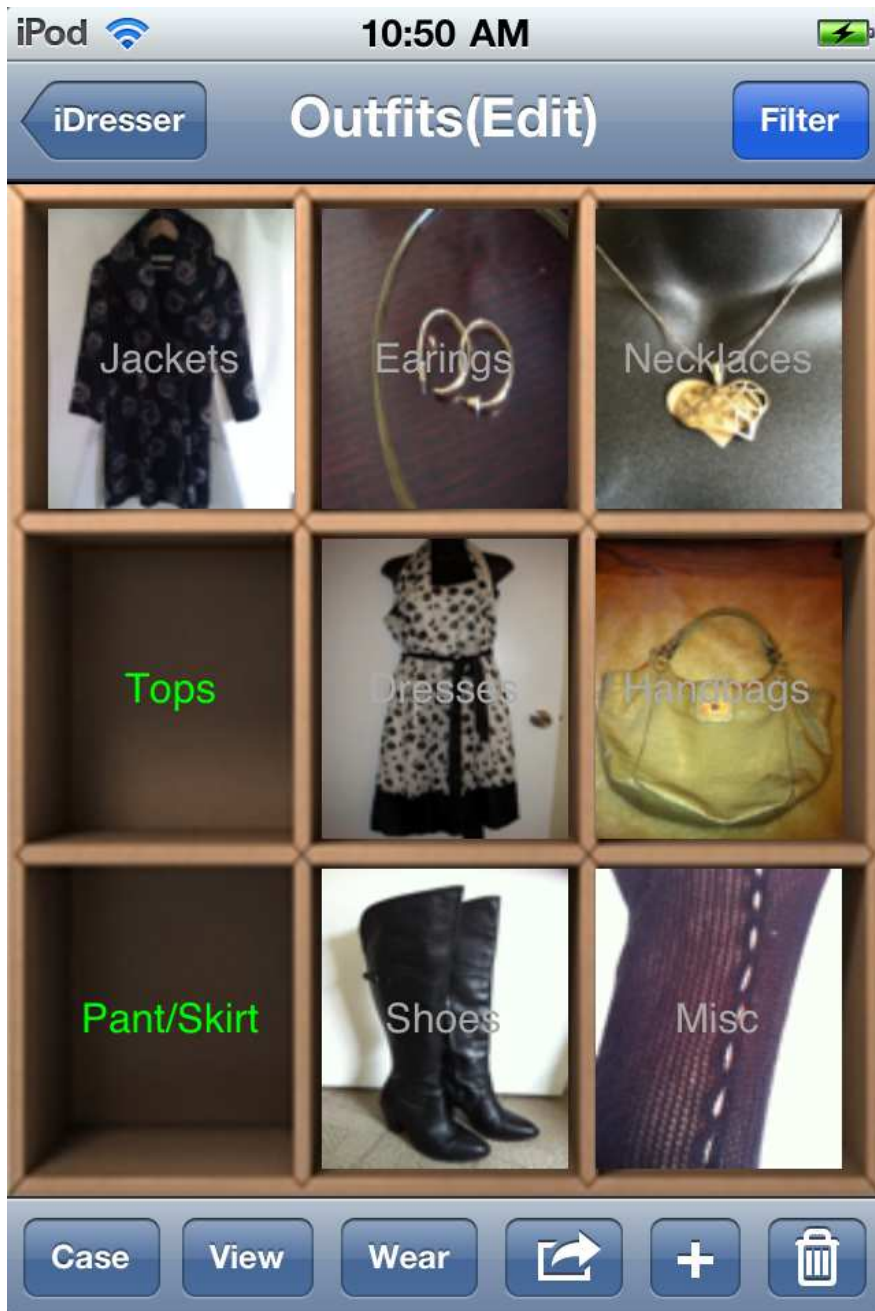
When in edit mode you change the items that make up the outfit.

Drag a draw vertically or horizontally a vertical or horizontal scrollable list of thumbnail images will pop up displaying all the items from the dragged draw.





You can search through the item thumbnails by dragging your finger in the direction of the pop up list, comparing the items against the outfit items in the other draws. Touch the desired item in the scrolling list to select the item to the outfit draw.



To cancel selection of a thumbnail drag one of the scrolling thumbnails at right angles to the direction of the scrolling list.



The scrolling list of items will be cancelled and the original draw item displayed.



The ability to scroll draw thumbnails horizontally or vertically enable you to compare a draw with all eight draws when creating an outfit.

On completion of making changes to the outfit touch the toolbar View button to return to browsing your outfits.

The View button text will change back to Edit.

When editing an outfit scrolling between outfits is disabled. Likewise when viewing outfits the verticle and horizontal scrolling thumbnails lists are disabled.



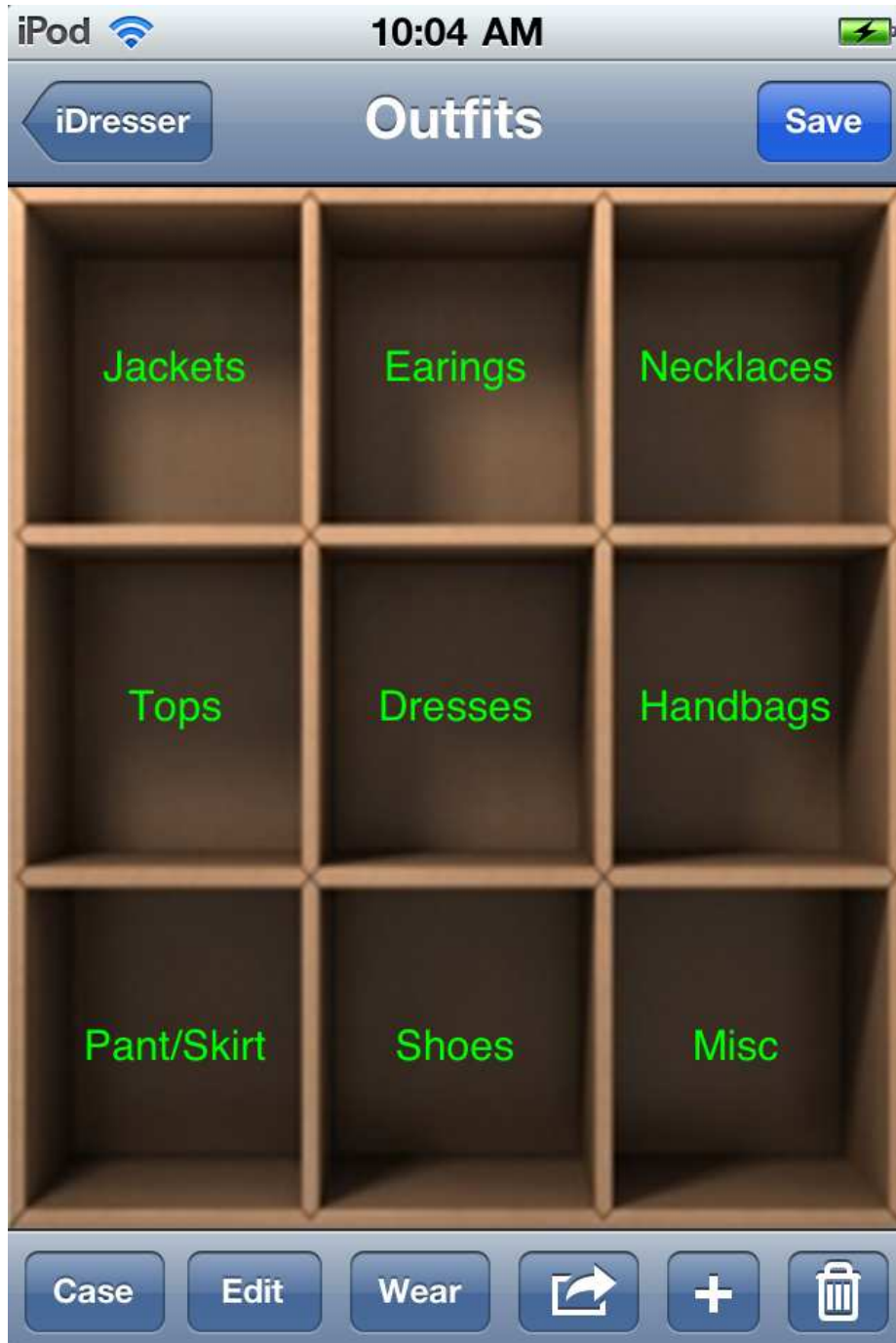
Outfit Info

Outfit info is the same as the item info without seasons or colour.

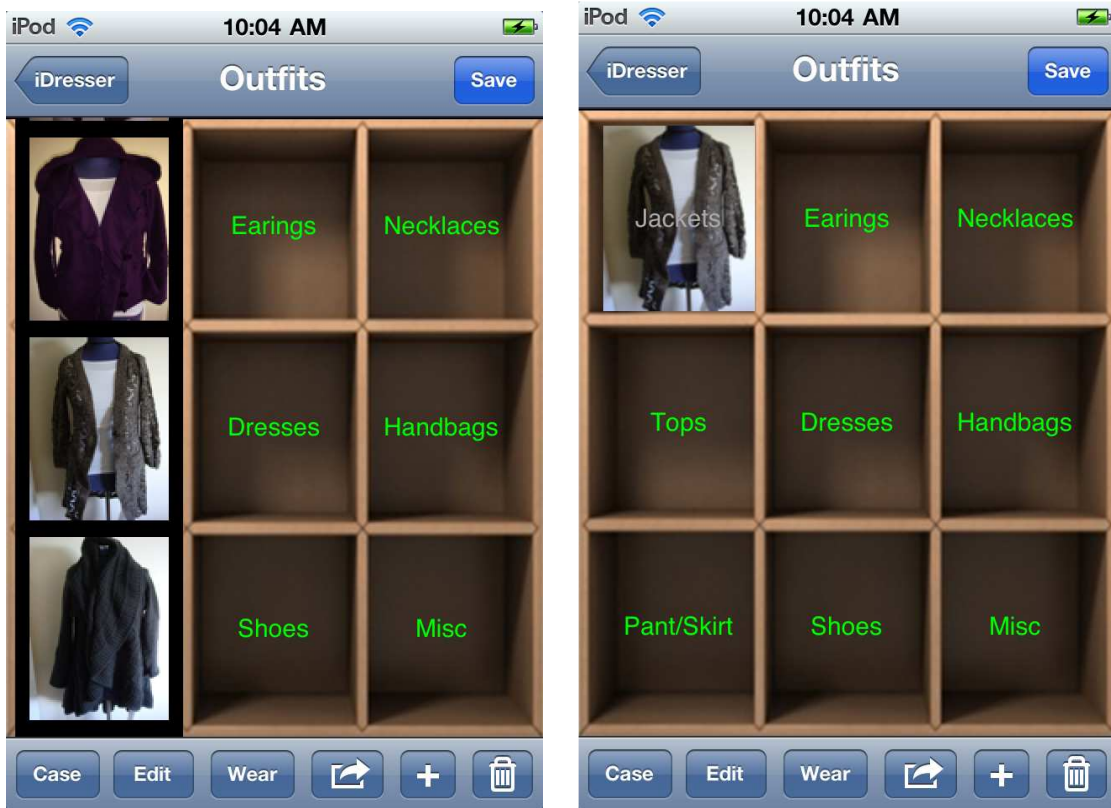


Add Outfit

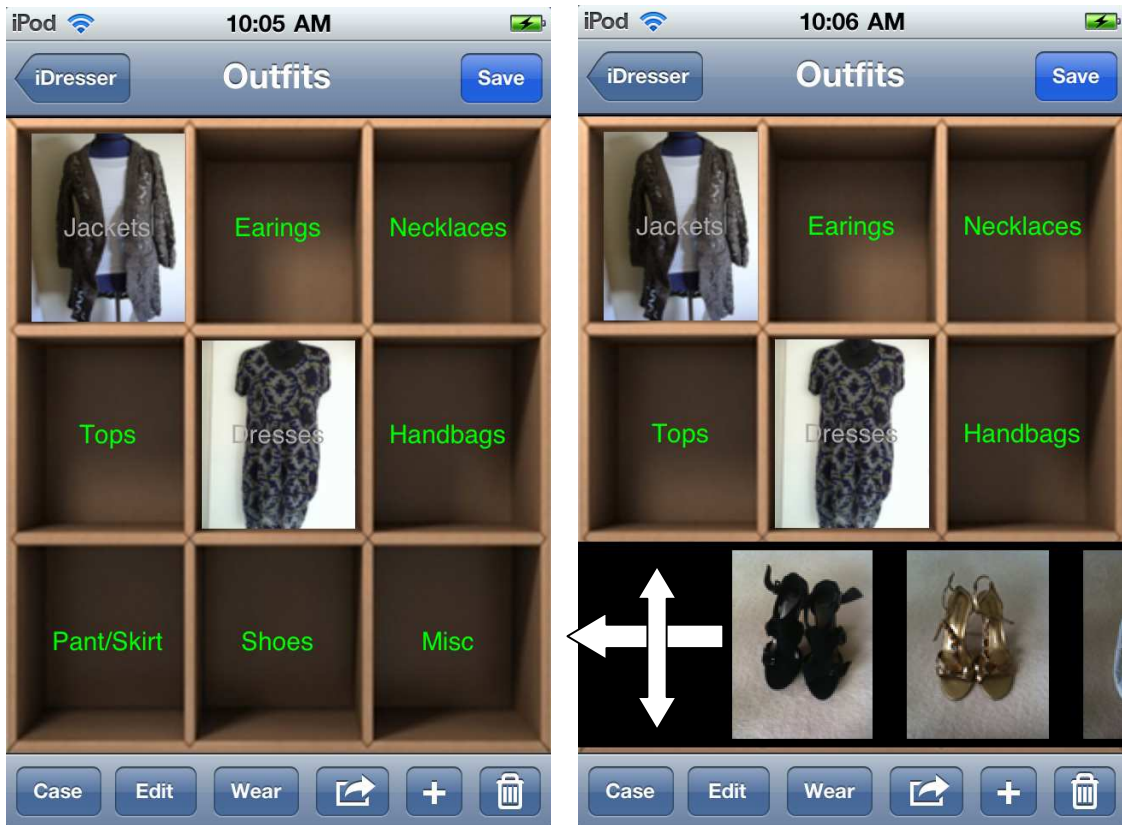
Touch  to create a new outfit.



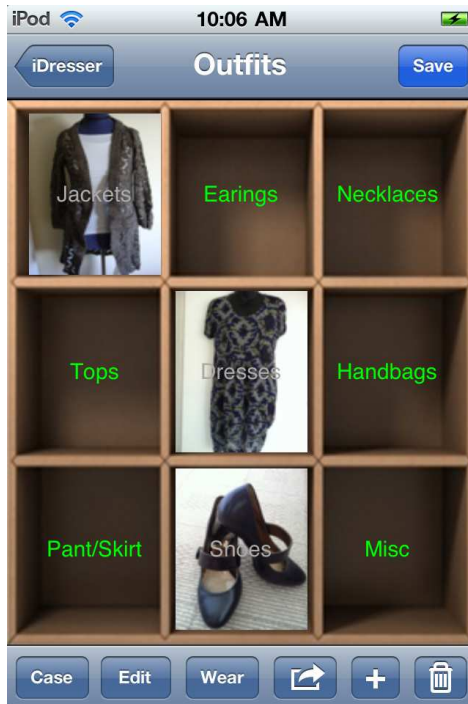
Drag and item horizontally or vertically as described in Edit above and select item to the Outfit.

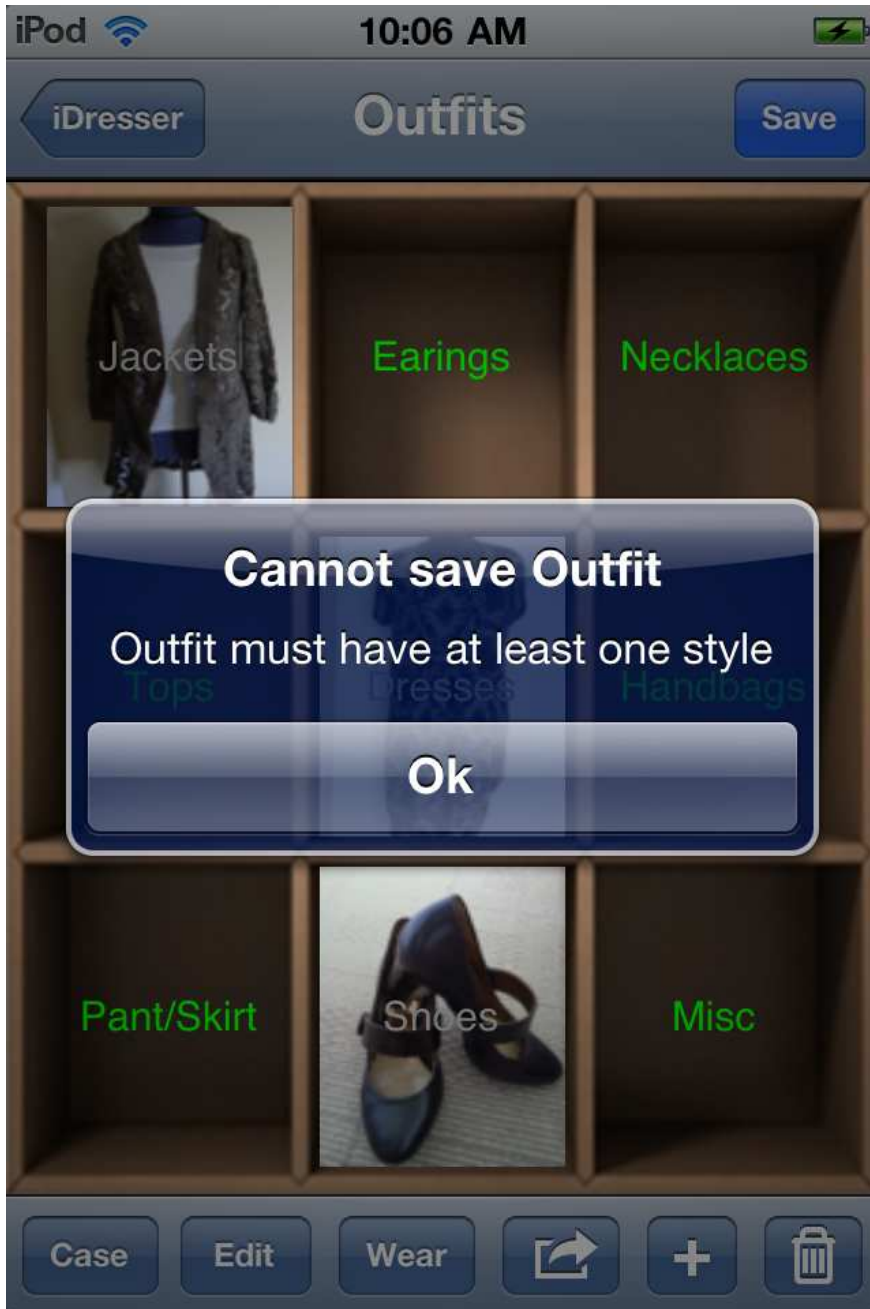


Continue to select items until all the desired items in the Outfit have been selected.



Touch the Save button to save the outfit the closet.
An outfit must have a style to be saved to the wardrobe.



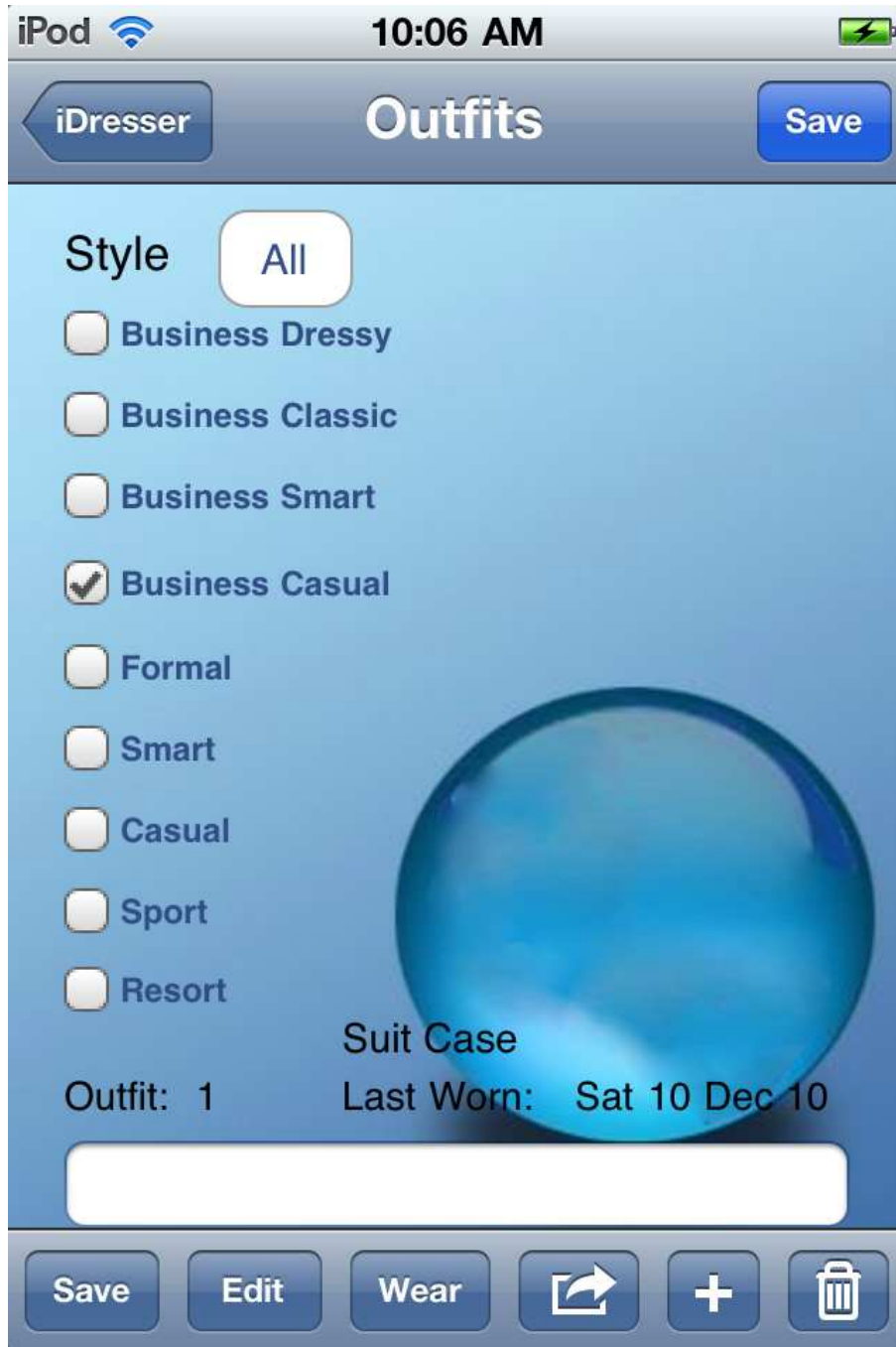


Touch the Save button to save the outfit to the closet.

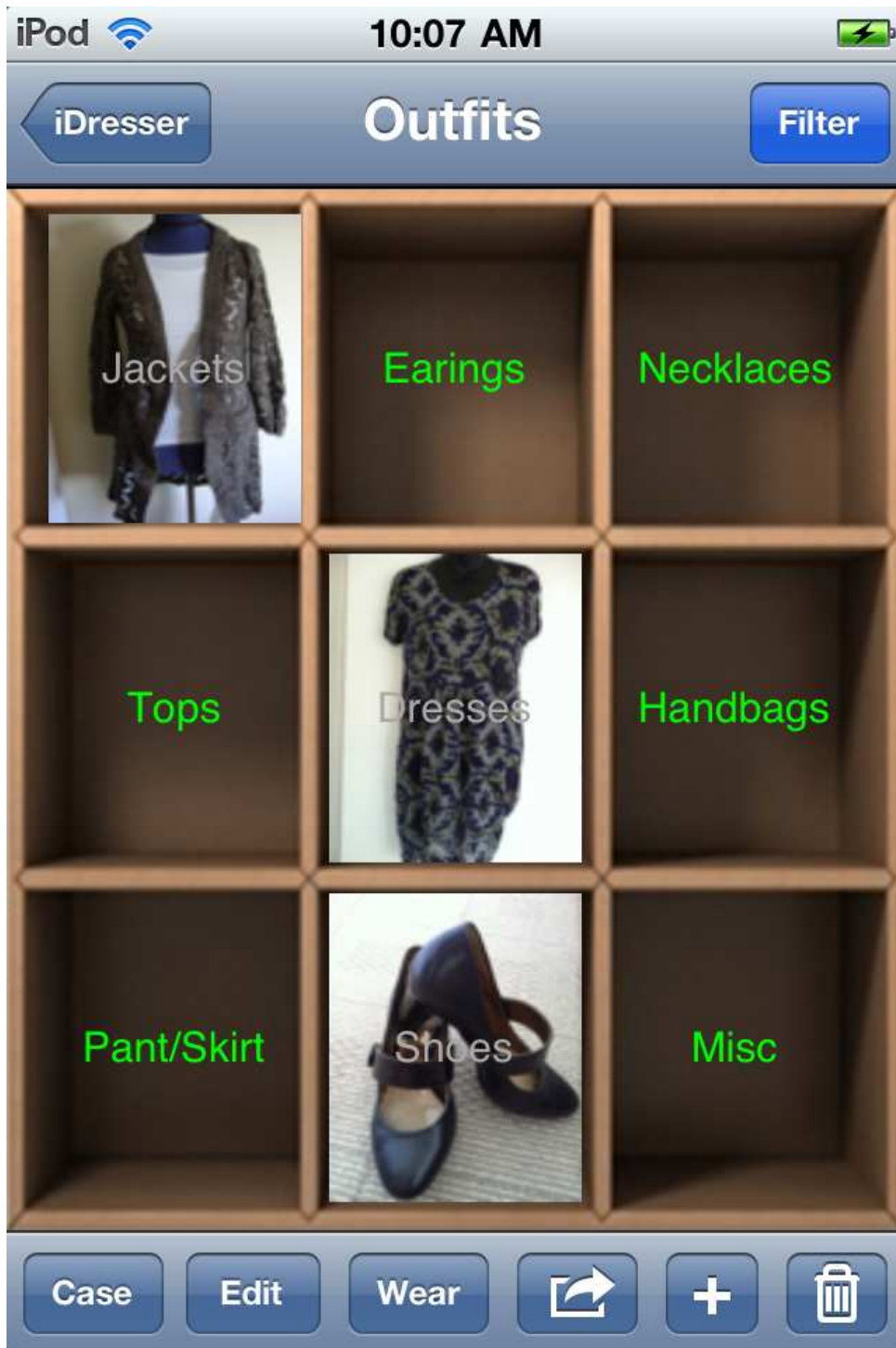
An outfit must have a style to be saved to the wardrobe.



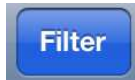
Touch the info button to assign a style to the Outfit.



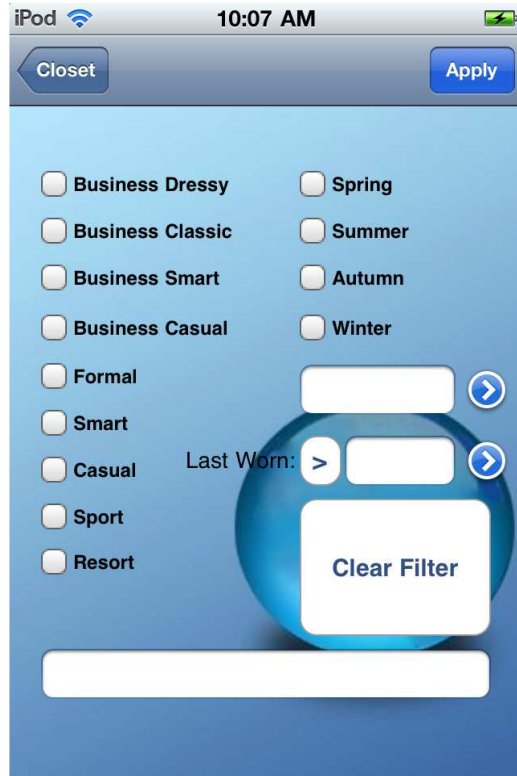
When adding an item Touch the save button at the top right to store the outfit info in your wardrobe and return to the outfit image view.



Filter



Touch the Filter button at the top right of the closet and outfit view to select a subset of items from the closet by item and outfit attributes.

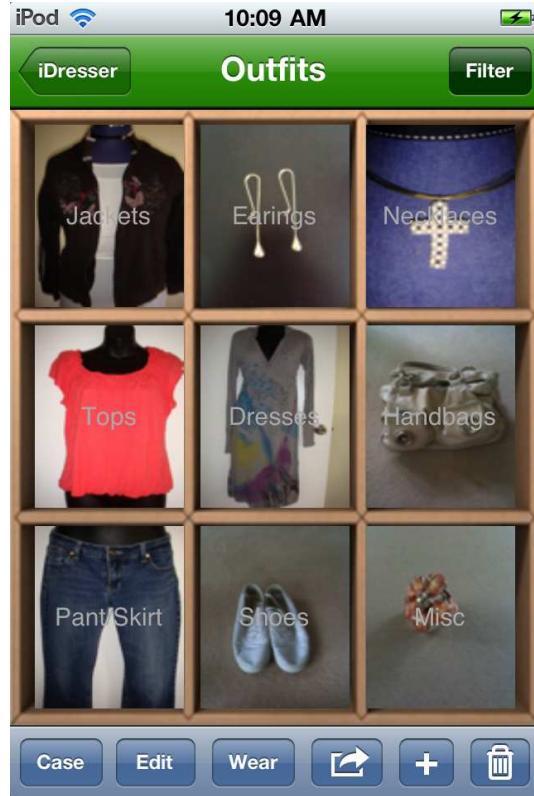


Select the desired attributes you wish to filter the closet items on and touch Apply.


The title bar will change to green to indicate you are browsing the closet with a filter displaying only the selected items as defined by the Filter view selections.

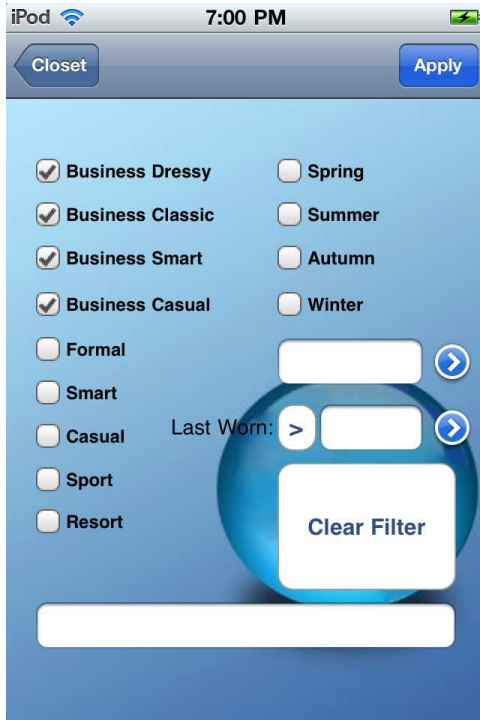


Now when you browse the closet only items whose style is "Business Smart and Classic" will be displayed.



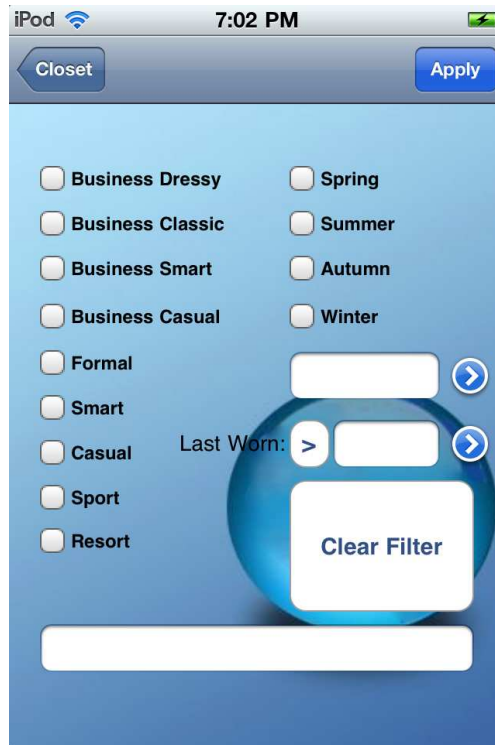
You can search for item last worn before or after a nominated date.

Touch the  button the right of "Last Worn:" and select a date, touch > to toggle between > and <



To remove the search filter touch the “Clear Filter” button followed by “Apply”.

The title bar will return to a shade of blue and all items and outfits will be displayed while browsing.



Suit Case



Touch the Suitcase main menu button to browse the items and outfits currently marked as being in your suitcase.
Once touched the Suitcase menu is displayed.



The number of items and outfits currently marked as in the suitcase are display on the suitcase browse Items and outfits menu buttons.

Items

Touch the Items button to browse the items in the suitcase. This is similar to browsing items in a closet draw above.

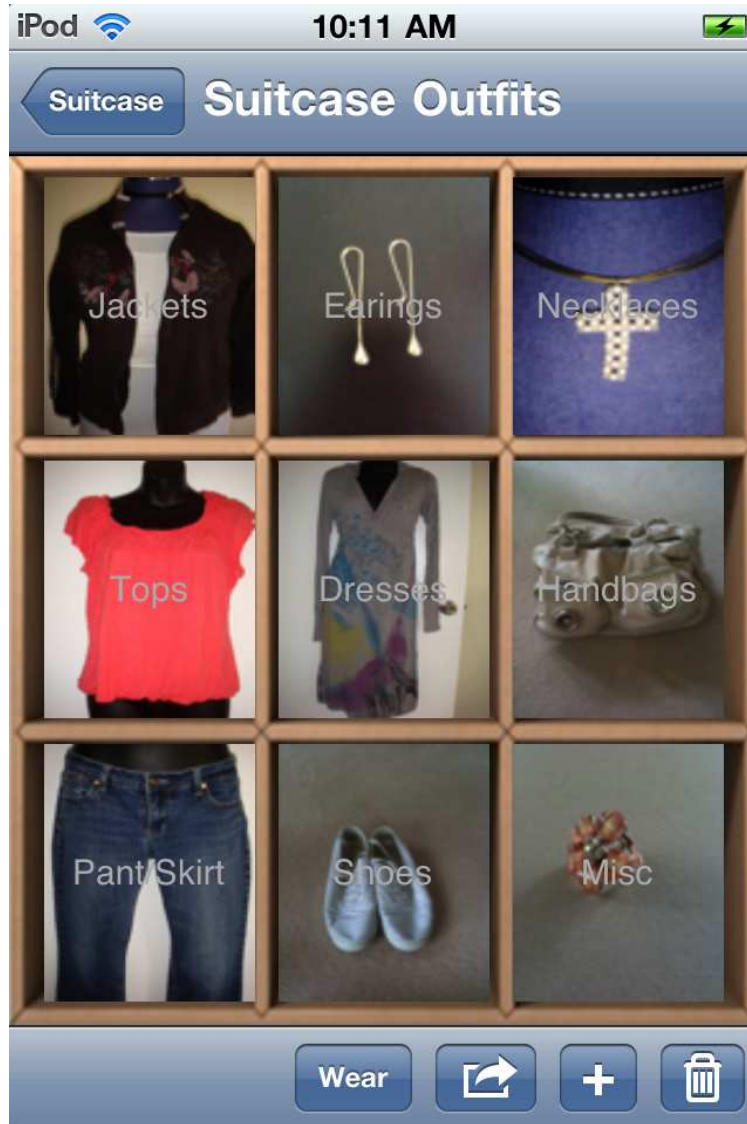


The toolbar button items perform the following tasks:

Outfits

Touch the Outfit button to browse the items in the suitcase. This is similar to browsing outfits in the closet above.



The toolbar button items perform the following tasks:

Wear	Sets the outfit Last Worn date and time to now
Info	Displays the outfit information, style, season, color etc.
Add	Adds a new outfit to the Suitcase, and alternative method to touching the case button while browsing outfits in the closet
Delete	Removes the current outfit from the suitcase

Empty

Touch Empty to delete all items and outfits from the suitcase.



Whish List

As you browse the fashion stores you can capture items that you would like to buy. You can use the wish list to store these items and compare them to items in your wardrobe. If a good match you can make an informed purchase rather try and remember or second guess the content of your wardrobe.

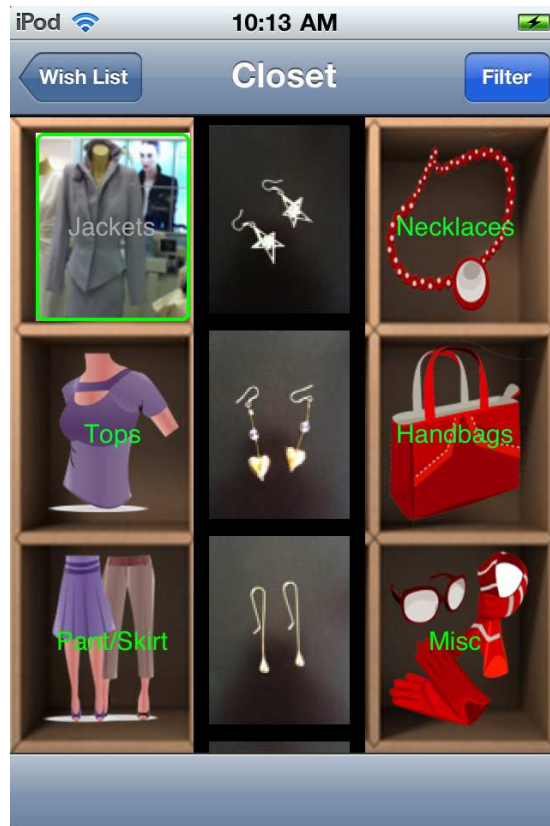
Touch the WishList main menu button to browse, add and remove items from your shopping wish list. This is similar to browsing items in the suit case above.



The toolbar button items perform the following tasks:

| Info | Displays the outfit information, typically the comment will contain store details. |
| Add | Adds a new outfit to the Wish List, similar to add item above |
| Delete | Removes the current item from the Wish List |

To compare items in your Wish List with your Closet, touch the Closet button at the top right of the display.



The Wish List item is high lighted in green and the other eight draw items can be browsed similar to selecting items when adding an Outfit as described above.

You can browse the other draws in your closet comparing the items with the wish list item.





Style Guru

Touch the Style Guru main menu button to gain access to one of the worlds leading Style consultants. You will gain access to a wealth professional advice, colour and style analysis, how to's, free downloads and professional services.

Out with the Old and In with the New

Maintenance

The Maintenance panel provides commands to Backup and Restore your data to Dropbox, log on to Dropbox. Empty your database or restore the demonstration database.

Backup and Restore is done to and from Dropbox. Dropbox is a Web-based file hosting service operated by Dropbox, Inc. that uses cloud computing to enable users to store and share files and folders with others across the Internet. Dropbox provides 2 Gigabyte storage for free.

Using backup and restore you can transfer your data between devices i.e. iPhone and iPad or iPod, or if you purchase a new phone you can transfer your wardrobe from your old phone to your new phone.

Touch the Maintenance main menu button to display the Maintenance Panel.



Link Dropbox

The first time you enter the Maintenance panel there will be displayed a “Link Dropbox” button. You must log on to Dropbox if you already have a Dropbox account, or create a Dropbox account before you can backup and restore your data to and from the Internet.



Enter your email address and a password. If you do not have a Dropbox account touch the text “Create an account”. A drop box account will be created and you can access your account and 2 Gigabyte of data from your iPhone, Mac or PC Personal Computers.

Dropbox have an fro each platform, simply install the app on your phone or computer and you can access your 2Gig of storage, share photos and data with friends or other computers.

If you already have an account touch the “Link” button to logon to Dropbox.

The “Link Dropbox” button will change to “Unlink Dropbox” once logged on successfully.

The iDresser will stay logged on to Dropbox until you deliberately “Unlink Dropbox”, even if you exit iDresser and turn off your phone.

Backup

Touch backup to backup your wardrobe to Dropbox.



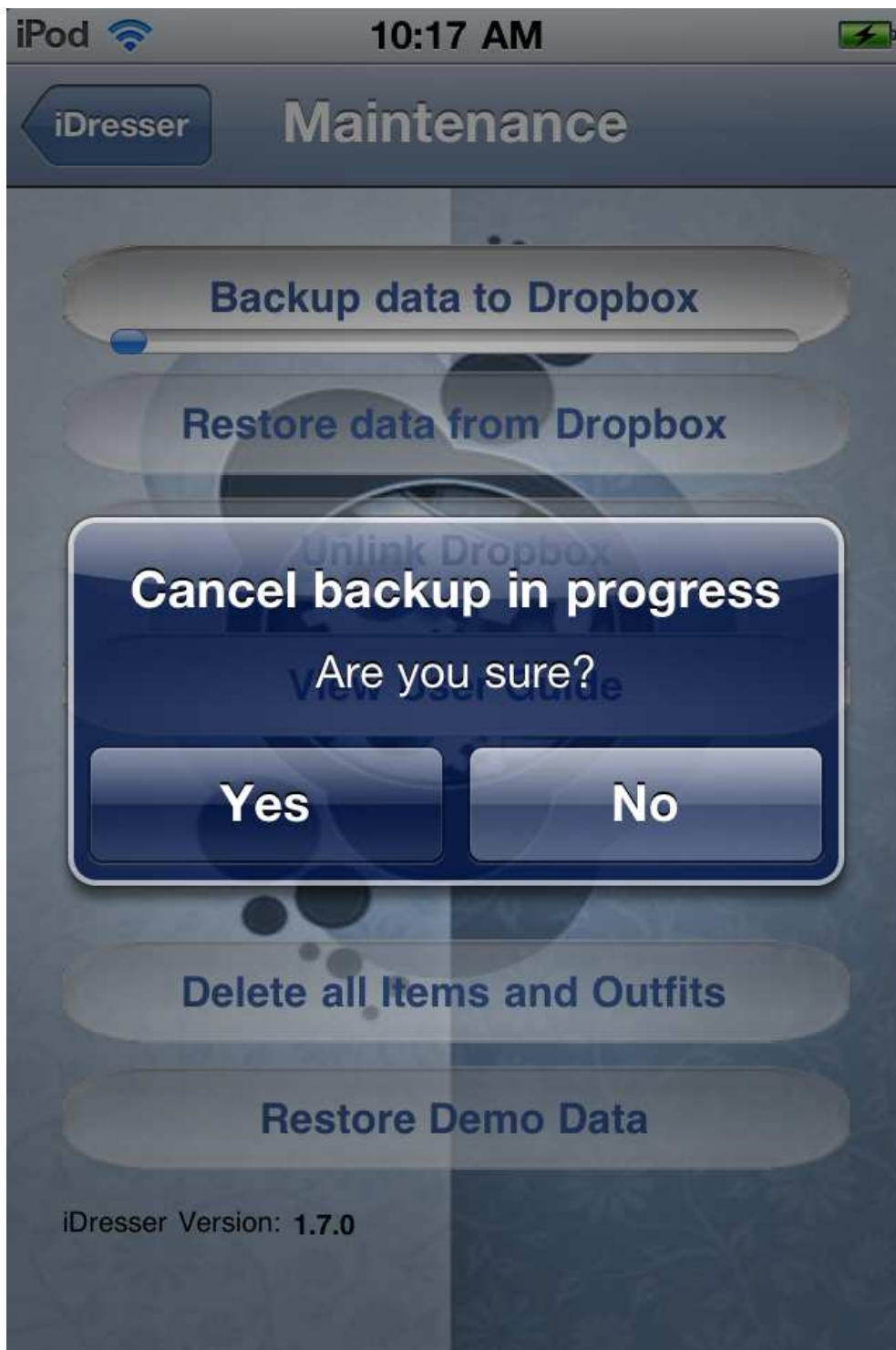
A prompt to continue will be displayed.
Touch No to abort the backup.

Touch yes to continue.



A progress bar will be displayed at the bottom of the Backup button. It takes approximately 4 to 6 seconds to backup one item depending on the quality of your internet connection. Images of items in the wardrobe are between 150 to 250kb. The demonstration database has 83 items in the closet and typically takes 8 minutes plus to backup.

To cancel a backup in progress simply touch the Back button while the backup is in progress.



Touch yes to cancel the backup, No to continue.

Restore

Touch Restore to restore your wardrobe from your last backup to Dropbox.



A prompt to continue will be displayed.
Touch No to abort the restore.

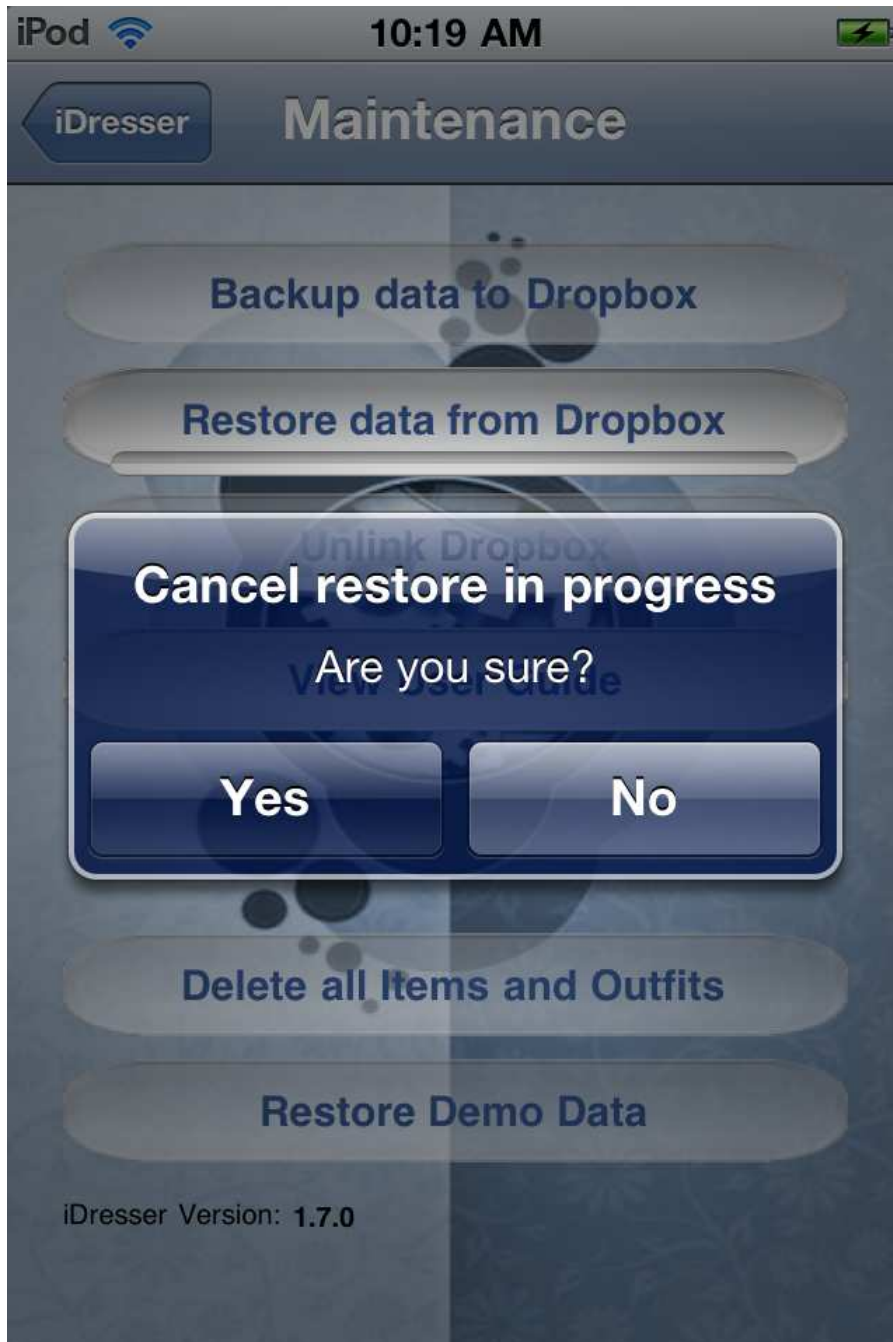
Touch yes to continue.



A progress bar will be displayed at the bottom of the Restore button. Similar to backup it takes approximately 4 to 6 seconds to backup one item depending on the quality of your internet connection. Images of items in the wardrobe are between 150 to 250kb. The demonstration database has 83 items in the closet and typically takes 12 minutes plus to restore. Typical internet connections have a faster upload speed than download speed.

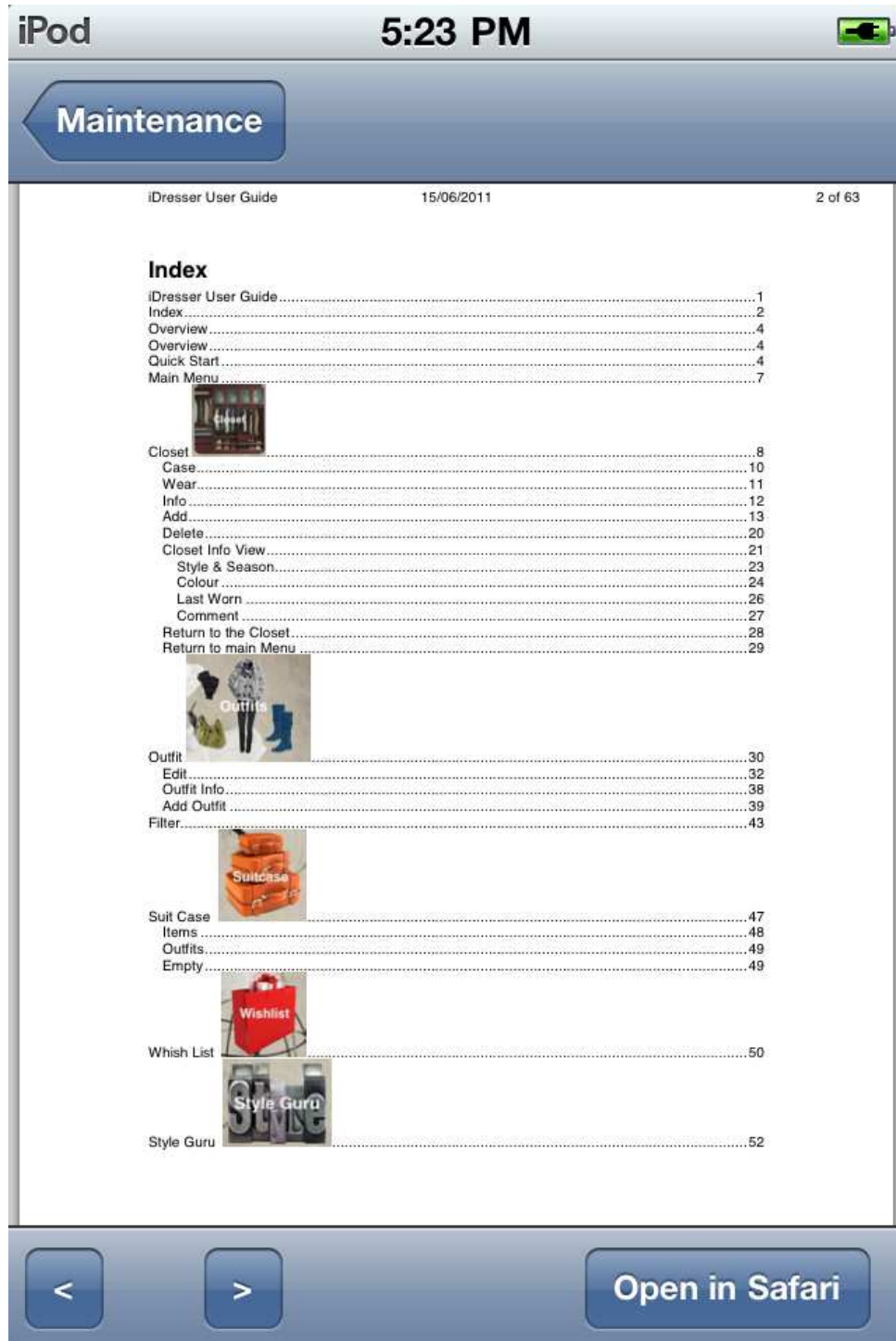
The Restore files are loaded to a temporary database and do not overwrite your existing data until all the data has been downloaded successfully. The restore operation can be cancelled any time with affecting your existing data.

Touch the Restore button while a restore is in progress to cancel the operation.

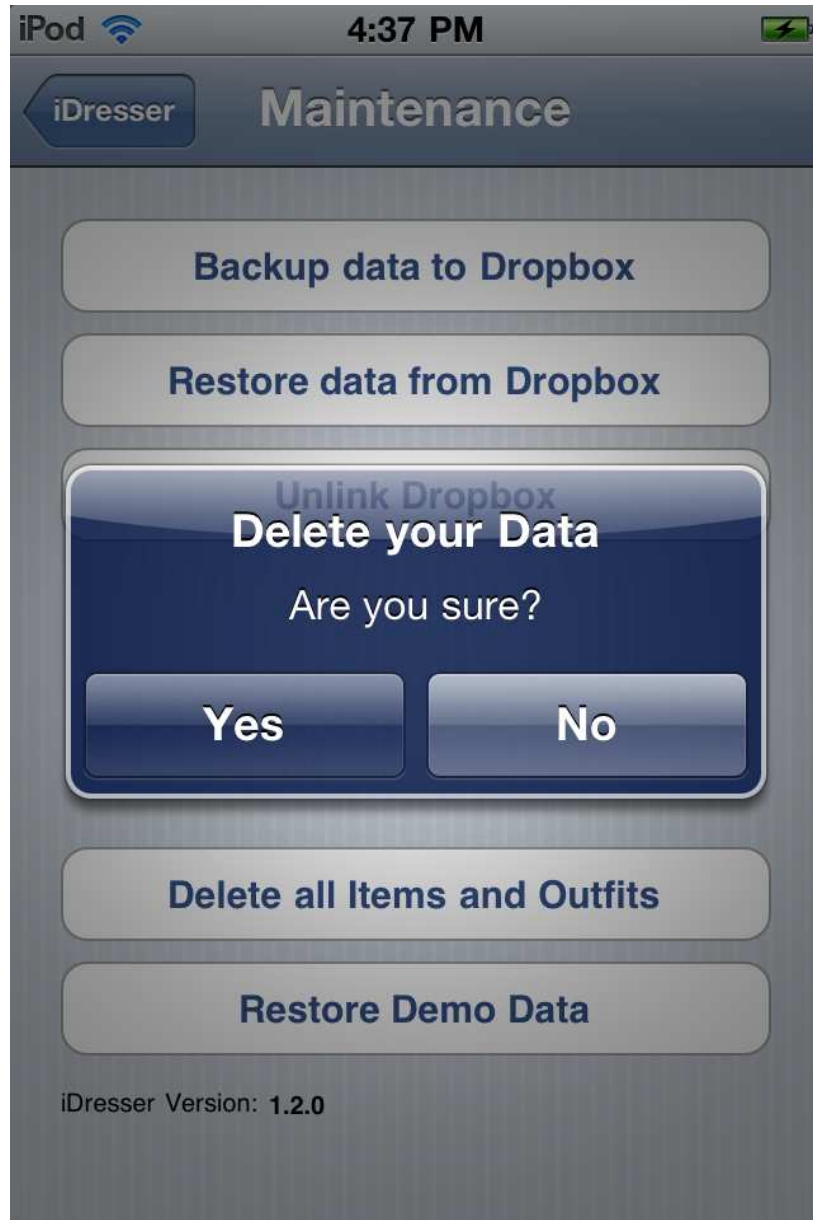

Delete All Items and Outfits

Touch the “Delete All Items and Outfits” to create an empty database in preparation from starting a new wardrobe.

A prompt will be displayed asking you to confirm you wish to delete you wardrobe.

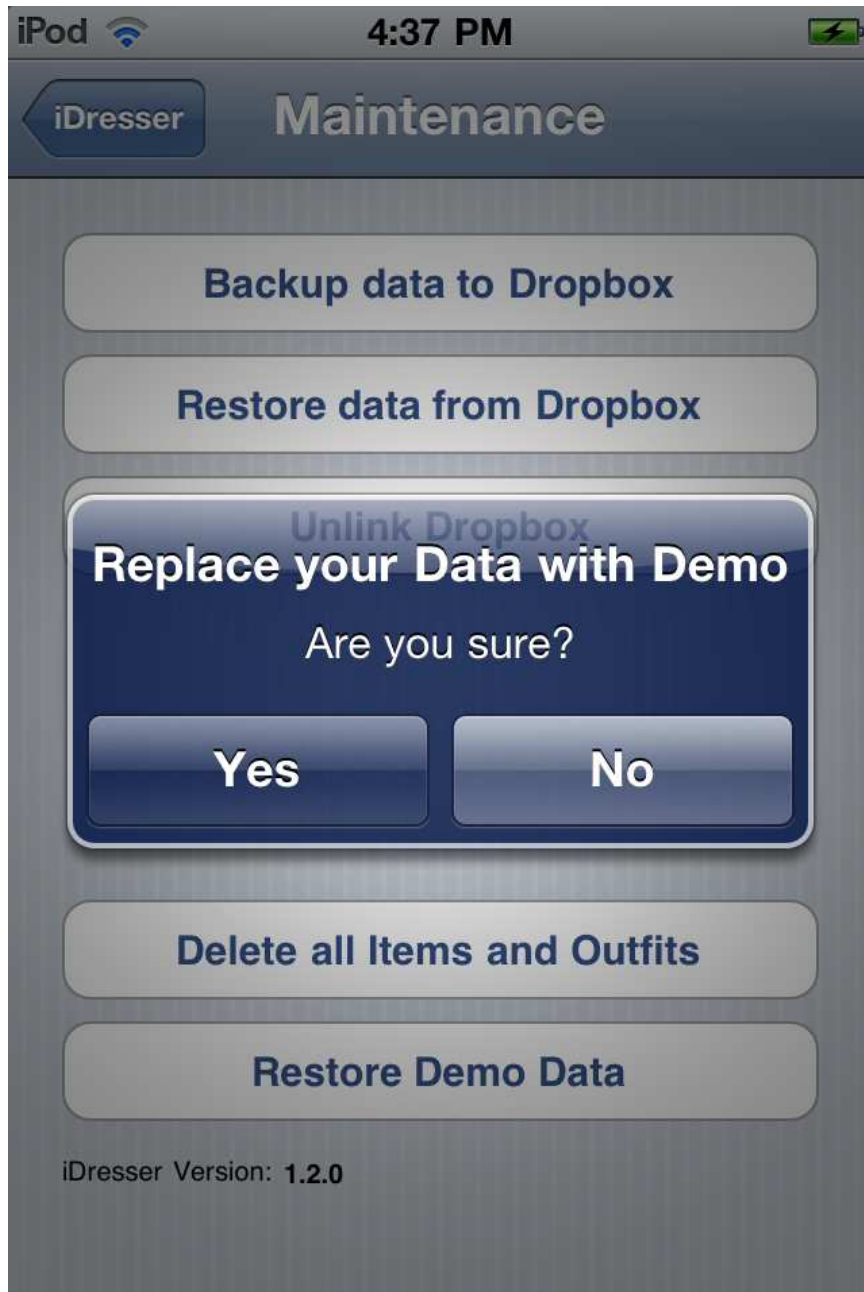


Touch Yes to delete your data and create an empty database.
Touch No to ignore and return to the Maintenance Menu.

Restore Demo Data

Touch the “Restore Demo Data” to replace your existing closet with the demonstration closet that comes with iDresser. This will overwrite your existing data and it will be lost.

A prompt will be displayed asking you to confirm you wish to delete you wardrobe



Touch Yes to restore the demonstration data.
Touch No to ignore and return to the Maintenance Menu
